3. That the following described Application Lands, under the Commission's Order 440-12 (corrected 11/90), were established by the Commission as 320 acre drilling and spacing units for the Mesaverde formation:

4. That the following described Application Lands, under the Commission's Order 479-1, were established by the Commission as 320 acre drilling and spacing units for the Mesaverde formation:

Township 6 South, Range 96 West, 6th P.M.

Sections 1: S/2 Section 12: All Section 23: N/2 Section 24: All

- 5. That due to the limited drainage areas of Mesaverde Group wells, it is no longer appropriate or necessary to have large drilling and spacing units covering the Application Lands. Applicant therefore requests that these 320 acre drilling and spacing units be vacated as they apply to the Mesaverde Group. There are no Mesaverde Group wells located on any of the Application Lands.
- 6. That the above-proposed vacation of drilling and spacing units will allow development of the Mesaverde Group to occur; will not promote waste; will not violate correlative rights and will assure the greatest ultimate recovery of gas and associated hydrocarbon substances from the reservoir.
- 7. That the names and addresses of the interested parties according to the information and belief of the Applicant are set forth in Exhibit A attached hereto and made a part hereof.

WHEREFORE, Applicant respectfully requests that this matter be set for hearing in August, 2005, that notice be given as required by law and that upon such hearing this Commission enter its order consistent with Applicant's proposals as set forth above.
