APPLICATION

COMES NOW Williams Production RMT Company ("Applicant"), a Delaware corporation, by its attorneys, Poulson, Odell & Peterson, LLC, and makes application to the Oil and Gas Conservation Commission of the State of Colorado for an order vacating certain 320 acre drilling and spacing units previously ordered by the Commission applicable to the Mesaverde Group covering certain described lands in the Rulison Field area in Garfield County and in support of its application states and alleges as follows:

- 1. That Applicant is a corporation duly authorized to conduct business in the State of Colorado.
- 2. That Applicant owns a leasehold interest (or has a right to acquire same) in a substantial portion of the following described lands:

Township 6 South, Range 94 West, 6th P. M.

Section 1: Lots 3, 4, 5, 6, S/2N/2, S/2 (ALL) Section 2: Lots 1, 2, 3, 4, S/2N/2, S/2 (ALL) Section 3: Lots 1, 2, 3, 4, S/2N/2, S/2 (ALL) Section 12: Lots 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8 (N/2)

(hereinafter "Application Lands")

- 3. That the Application Lands, under the Commission's Order 139-14, were established by the Commission as 320-acre drilling and spacing units for the Mesaverde formation.
- 4. That the Application Lands were approved for eight (8) wells to be optionally drilled into and produced from the Williams Fork Formation within each 320-acre drilling and spacing unit under the Commission's Order 139-27.

- 5. That due to the limited drainage areas of Mesaverde Group wells, it is no longer appropriate or necessary to have large drilling and spacing units covering the Application Lands. Applicant therefore requests that these 320-acre drilling and spacing units be vacated as they apply to the Mesaverde Group. The S/2 of Section 12 will continue as a 320-acre drilling and spacing unit subject to both of the above described orders.
- 6. That the above-proposed vacation of drilling and spacing units will allow development of the Mesaverde Group to occur; will not promote waste; will not violate correlative rights and will assure the greatest ultimate recovery of gas and associated hydrocarbon substances from the reservoir.
- 7. That the names and addresses of the interested parties according to the information and belief of the Applicant are set forth in Exhibit A attached hereto and made a part hereof.
