<u>APPLICATION</u>

EnCana Oil & Gas (USA) Inc. ("Applicant"), by and through its attorneys, Beatty & Wozniak, P.C., respectfully submits this Application to the Oil and Gas Conservation Commission of the State of Colorado (the "Commission") for an order lifting the moratorium on drilling and completion operations established in Commission Order Number 1V-276, dated August 16, 2004, and in support of its Application states and alleges as follows:

- 1. Applicant is a corporation duly authorized to conduct business in the State of Colorado.
 - 2. Applicant owns various leasehold interests in the following described lands:

(hereafter the "Application Lands").

3. In 2004, Applicant was a party to an enforcement proceeding relating to a natural gas seep in the West Divide Creek area in Garfield County, Colorado. The order resulting from that proceeding established a moratorium on drilling and completion operations within a 2-mile radius of the seep, which includes some or all of the Application Lands.

The moratorium was required to remain in place:

until the staff evaluates (1) the effectiveness of the Notice to All Operators Drilling Wells to the Mesaverde Group or Deeper in the Mamm Creek Field, Garfield County, effective July 23, 2004 ("notice"), and (2) EnCana's compliance with any applicable Site Investigation and Remediation Workplan, Form 27, as approved or amended by the COGCC staff ("investigation and remediation requirements"), related to the gas seep in the area of West Divide Creek. After the COGCC staff evaluates the effectiveness of the notice and EnCana's compliance with investigation and remediation requirements, it shall make any modifications it deems necessary and lift the moratorium when, in the COGCC staff's determination, the appropriate safety precautions are set forth in the notice and EnCana has complied with all investigation and remediation requirements related to the gas seep in the area of West Divide Creek.

- 4. Applicant desires to drill, complete and produce new Williams Fork wells (some or all of which will also be drilled into and produce from the Iles formation) on the Application Lands consistent with applicable State and Federal regulations. Five wells have been drilled by other operators in the moratorium area since the issuance of Order No. 1V-276, and all such wells were drilled and completed without incident.
- 5. The first condition in Order No. 1V-276 for lifting the moratorium has been met. On July 11, 2005, Commission Staff prepared an "Assessment of the Effectiveness of the Mamm Creek Notice to Operators and Recommendation" which indicated that the referenced Notice to Operators has been completely successful in preventing the conditions which led to the issuance of the moratorium:

It is staff's belief that the measures required by the [Notice to Operators] make drilling within the moratorium safe and will prevent the conditions and circumstances that resulted in the Divide Creek Gas Seep. Staff believes that drilling can safely resume within the moratorium area without impact to the public health, safety, welfare and the environment.

Since the time the Notice to Operators was first issued, Applicant has continued to provide information, and recommendations based on field experiences, to Commission Staff in connection with the Notice to Operators, and in fact the Notice has been refined and revised based on such information.

- 6. The second condition in Order No. 1V-276 for lifting the moratorium has also been met. Applicant has complied in all respects with the requirements of the Form 27 Site Investigation and Remediation Workplan approved by Commission Staff pursuant to Order No. 1V-276. As noted in the most recent Commission Staff Report dated December 6, 2005, Applicant has conducted (and continues to conduct) an extensive groundwater and surface water sampling program in the moratorium area and beyond, as well as a remediation system to address groundwater contamination in the vicinity of the seep. Commission Staff has stated in prior Staff Reports that the remediation system has been observed to be successfully containing and remediating the contamination in the area. See, e.g., Staff Report dated October 31, 2005. Based on the extensive monitoring conducted over the last eighteen months, contamination has only ever been detected in groundwater or surface water in the immediate vicinity of the seep.
- 7. Applicant intends to comply fully, in all drilling and completion operations, with the requirements of the Notice to Operators (as amended), as well as with the Director's Bradenhead Testing and Reporting requirements for the Mamm Creek Field Area dated August 23, 2004.
- 8. In late 2004 and early 2005, Applicant's contractors performed walking surveys for gas seeps in the moratorium area; reports of those surveys have been provided to the Commission. Applicant intends to follow its current field practices for groundwater and surface water baseline sampling, consisting of sampling surface water features and groundwater within

½ mile of any well before drilling. Applicant commits to work with Commission Staff to develop an appropriate post-drilling monitoring program. Data from all sampling will be provided to Commission Staff, as well as to the applicable landowner for each sampling location.

- Applicant commits to reduce and contain surface impacts from operations to the extent practicable by, for example, drilling new wells from existing pads and drilling multiple wells from each pad.
- 10. In recent months, Applicant has provided large amounts of data for inclusion in the Hydrogeologic Study by Garfield County. Applicant understands that the Study is nearly complete and an initial draft report and figures will be submitted within a few days to the Commission and to Garfield County for review. Applicant intends to comply with the recommendations of that report to the extent such recommendations are implemented, whether formally or informally, by Commission Staff.
- 11. Applicant's plans to drill are supported by a number of surface and mineral owners in the Application Lands. Applicant has sent information to all surface owners in the Application Lands relating to the moratorium, the request to lift the moratorium, and Applicant's plans of operations as described herein. Applicant intends to hold one or more public information sessions for surface and mineral owners in the area prior to the hearing in this matter.
- 12. The names and addresses of interested parties according to the information and belief of the Applicant are set forth in Exhibit A attached hereto and made a part hereof. In addition, pursuant to the request of the Hearings Manager, the names and addresses of surface owners and other interested parties are also set forth in Exhibit A. Applicant hereby certifies that in accordance with Rule 503.d., a copy of this Application will be served on all parties listed in Exhibit A within seven days hereof.

WHEREFORE, Applicant respectfully requests that this matter be set for hearing, that notice be given as required by law and that upon such hearing this Commission enter its order consistent with Applicant's proposals as set forth above.
