APPLICATION

COMES NOW Antero Resources Picance Corporation ("Applicant"), a Delaware corporation, by its attorneys, Poulson, Odell & Peterson, LLC, and makes application to the Oil and Gas Conservation Commission of the State of Colorado for an order vacating a designated 320 acre drilling and spacing unit previously ordered by the Commission applicable to the Williams Fork Formation and Iles Formation of the Mesaverde Group covering certain described lands in the Mamm Creek Field area in Garfield County and replacing it with two 160 acre drilling and spacing units for the Williams Fork Formation. In support of its application, Applicant states and alleges as follows:

1. That Applicant is a corporation duly authorized to conduct business in the State of Colorado.

2. That Applicant owns a leasehold interest in a portion of the following described lands:

Township 6 South, Range 93 West, 6th P.M. Section 15: E/2

(hereinafter "Application Lands")

3. That the Application Lands, under the Commission's Order 191-21, were established by the Commission as a 320 acre drilling and spacing unit for the Williams Fork Formation.

4. That when the application in Order No. 191-21 was filed Applicant anticipated that it would have the SE/4 of the Application Lands leased. However, Applicant was

unsuccessful in such efforts. Applicant therefore wants to proceed with drilling operations in the SW/4 of the Application Lands in respect of which it does own a leasehold interest without having to pool the SE/4 of the Application Lands. Therefore, in addition to vacating the Application Lands as a 320 acre drilling and spacing unit, Applicant requests that the SE/4 and the SW/4 of the Application Lands to be established as approximate 160 acre drilling and spacing units for the Williams Fork Formation.

5. That the above-proposed vacation of the 320 acre drilling and spacing unit and the establishment in its place of two approximate 160 acre drilling units will allow development of the Williams Fork Formation to occur; will not promote waste; will not violate correlative rights and will assure the greatest ultimate recovery of gas and associated hydrocarbon substances from the reservoir.

6. That the Application Lands will continue, per the provisions of Order 191-21 to be approved for the drilling of ten (10) acre density wells except that the setback rules established under such order will apply to the boundaries of the newly established 160 acre drilling and spacing units.

7. That the names and addresses of the interested parties according to the information and belief of the Applicant are set forth in Exhibit A attached hereto and made a part hereof.

WHEREFORE, Applicant respectfully requests that this matter be set for hearing in October, 2006, that notice be given as required by law and that upon such hearing this Commission enter its order consistent with Applicant's proposals as set forth above.
