VERIFIED APPLICATION

Catamount Royalty Partners, Ltd. ("Applicant"), through its undersigned counsel, respectfully submits this application to the Oil and Gas Conservation Commission of the State of Colorado ("Commission") pursuant to C.R.S. § 34-60-116 and Commission Rule 530 for an order pooling the interests of any and all unlocated owners, if any, of royalty or other interests in the mineral estate for purposes of the joint development and operation of wells in an established 320-acre drilling and spacing unit in the Fruitland Coal formation in the lands located in the N½, Section 36, Township 33 North, Range 7 West, N.M.P.M., La Plata County, Colorado. In support thereof, the Applicant states and alleges as follows:

1. The Applicant is a limited partnership duly authorized to conduct business in the State of Colorado.

2. The lands at issue in this Application are the following lands in La Plata County, Colorado:

Township 33 North, Range 7 West, N.M.P.M. Section 36: N¹/₂

(hereinafter the "Application Lands").

3. The Applicant is a present lessee pursuant to an oil and gas lease covering a portion of the Application Lands. As such, the Applicant is an owner of an interest in the mineral estate in the Application Lands as defined in the Commission rules and has standing to submit this Application pursuant to Commission Rule 503.b.2 and other law.

4. Other owners of interests in the mineral estate of the Application Lands include McElvain Oil & Gas Properties, Inc. ("McElvain") and JDH Resources Limited Liability Company ("JDH"). JDH is a present co-lessee with the Applicant while McElvain is a present lessee to other oil and gas leases authorizing development of other portions of the Application Lands. Both JDH and McElvain have advised the Applicant they support this Application.

5. McElvain is the operator of the Application Lands pursuant to a Joint Operating Agreement. The Applicant, McElvain and JDH are signatories to this Joint Operating Agreement.

6. Commission Orders 112-185 and 112-157 authorize the drilling of multiple Fruitland Coal formation wells on the Application Lands.

7. In 2006, McElvain, as operator, permitted, spudded and subsequently drilled and completed two Fruitland Coal formation wells on the Application Lands in compliance with applicable Commission orders and permits issued for these wells. Applicant and JDH consented to and participated in the drilling of these wells.

8. Upon information and belief, while all portions of the Application Lands are presently subject to valid oil and gas leases, McElvain and the Applicant, despite reasonable and diligent efforts, have been unable to locate certain other persons or entities that may or may not presently own royalty or other interests in the mineral estate of the Application Lands.

9. Since these other possible owners, if any, of royalty or other interests in the mineral estate of the Application Lands cannot now be located, and wells have been drilled on the Application Lands, the Applicant requests the Commission exercise its authority under C.R.S. § 34-60-116 and Commission Rule 530 and, following required notice, issue an order involuntarily pooling the interests of any and all unlocated possible royalty or other owners, if any, of interests in the mineral estate so that joint development and operation of wells in the Fruitland Coal formation on the Application Lands may continue.

10. As noted above, all known lessees of existing mineral interests have consented to the drilling of these wells and the filing of this Application. For this reason, there are no other located owners to whom additional information about the proposed or existing operations need be tendered or to whom reasonable lease terms need be offered as provided in Commission Rule 530 or other law.

11. The issuance by the Commission, after required notice, of an order involuntarily pooling all unlocated owners, if any, of royalty or other interests in the mineral estate of the Application Lands will promote the statutory purposes stated in the Oil and Gas Conservation Act and the Commission rules and also will be in accordance with C.R.S. § 34-60-116 and Commission Rule 530.

12. Upon information and belief, the parties listed in <u>Exhibit A</u> submitted with this Application are the persons or entities who presently own, or possibly own, interests in the mineral estate of the Application Lands to be pooled (other than overriding royalty interests) and, under Commission rules and other law, to whom notice should be tendered.

WHEREFORE, Applicant respectfully requests that this Application be set for hearing, notice of this Application and the scheduled hearing be given and, in accordance with Commission rules and other law, this Commission order:

A. That all unknown or unlocated owners, if any, of royalty or other interests in the mineral estate of the Application Lands be pooled involuntarily in order to promote joint development and operation of wells from the Fruitland Coal formation on the Application Lands in accordance with C.R.S. § 34-60-116 and Commission Rule 530, and that all owners of unleased mineral interests, if any, be treated as non-consenting owners as provided in C.R.S. § 34-60-116 and made subject to the terms and penalties provided for therein; and

B. That the Applicant be granted such other and further relief as this Commission deems just and proper.
