VERIFIED APPLICATION

EnCana Oil & Gas (USA) Inc. ("EnCana" or "Applicant"), by and through its attorneys, Beatty & Wozniak, P.C., respectfully submits this Application to the Oil and Gas Conservation Commission of the State of Colorado (the "Commission") for an order establishing well location rules applicable to the drilling and producing of wells from the Williams Fork and Iles Formations of the Mesaverde Group covering certain described lands in the Parachute/Rulison Fields, Garfield County, Colorado and in support of its Application states and alleges as follows:

- Applicant is a corporation duly authorized to conduct business in the State of Colorado.
 - 2. Applicant owns leasehold interests in the following described lands:

Township 7 South, Range 95 West, 6th P.M.

Section 16: All Section 17: E/2E/2 Section 19: All Section 20: All Section 21: All

Garfield County, Colorado.

(hereafter the "Application Lands").

3. The Application Lands are subject to Commission Order Nos. 139-48, 440-30, 440-38, 440-45 and 440-48, which authorizes the equivalent of one (1) well per 20-acre density for the production of oil and gas from the Williams Fork and Iles Formations of the Mesaverde group. Through this Application, the Applicant requests the effective well density be the equivalent of one well per 10 acres for the Williams Fork Formation with permitted wells to be located anywhere in the drilling and spacing

unit but no closer than 100 feet from the boundaries of the unit, except that where the established unit abuts or corners lands in respect of which the Commission has not at the time of drilling permit application granted the right to drill 10 acre density Williams Fork Formation wells, the well shall be located downhole no closer than 200 feet from the boundary of the drilling unit.

- 4. Specifically Order No. 440-48 established a 40-acre drilling and spacing unit for the E/2E/2 of Section 17 of the Application Lands, together with the approval of one well per 20-acres for production of the Williams Fork and Iles Formations.
- 5. Order No. 440-30 established a 40-acre drilling and spacing unit for the W/2 of Section 16 of the Application Lands, together with the approval of the well per 20 acres for production of the Williams Fork and Iles Formations.
- 6. Order No. 440-38 provided for the equivalent of 1 well per 20 acres or 16 wells for the 320-acre drilling and spacing unit in the E/2 of Section 16 of the Application Lands.
- 7. Order No. 440-45 created two 320-acre drilling and spacing units consisting of the N/2 and S/2 of said Section 19 of the Application Lands and allowed for the equivalent of 1 well per 20 acres within each 320-acre drilling and spacing unit for the Williams Fork and Iles Formations.
- 8. Order No. 139-48 established the equivalent of one well per 20 acres for the Williams Fork and Iles Formation for all of Sections 20 and 21 of the Application Lands.
- 9. That Applicant has drilled, tested and completed multiple wells in the Williams Fork Formation of the Mesaverde Group upon the Application Lands.
- 10. That to promote efficient drainage within the Williams Fork Formation of the Mesaverde Group of the Application Lands, the Commission should apply consistent rules to the Application Lands to increase the number of wells which can be optionally drilled into and produced from the Williams Fork Formation of the Application Lands to the equivalent of one well per 10 acres with the setbacks as requested in Paragraph 3 above.
- 11. That the above-proposed density will allow more efficient drainage of the Williams Fork Formation of the Mesaverde Group; will prevent waste; will not adversely

effect correlative rights and will assure the greatest ultimate recovery of gas and associated hydrocarbon substances from the reservoir.

12. That the names and addresses of the interested parties according to the information and belief of the Applicant are set forth in <u>Exhibit A</u> attached hereto and made a part hereof, and the undersigned certifies that copies of this Application shall be served on each interested party within the next seven days as required by Rule 503.d.

WHEREFORE, Applicant respectfully requests that this matter be set for hearing, that notice be given as required by law and that upon such hearing this Commission enter its order consistent with Applicant's proposals as set forth above.
