## **AMENDED** VERIFIED APPLICATION

Noble Energy Inc. ("Noble"), by and through its attorneys, Beatty & Wozniak, P.C., respectfully submits this **Amended** Application to the Oil and Gas Conservation Commission of the State of Colorado (the "Commission") for an order establishing density and well location rules applicable to the drilling and producing of wells from the Williams Fork and Iles Formations of the Mesaverde Group covering certain described lands in the Rulison Field, Garfield County, Colorado and in support of its Application states and alleges as follows:

- Applicant is a corporation duly authorized to conduct business in the State of Colorado.
  - 2. Applicant owns leasehold interests in the following described lands:

Township 7 South, Range 94 West, 6th P.M.

Section 17: Lot 3 (27.49 acres) & Lot 4 (26.96 acres)

Garfield County, Colorado.

(hereafter the "Application Lands").

3. The Application Lands are subject to Commission Order No. 139-73, which established forty (40) acre drilling and spacing units for the production of gas and associated hydrocarbons from the Williams Fork and Iles Formations for the Application Lands, allowing up to one well per 10 acres with the option of up to four wells, with the permitted well to be located no closer than 100 feet from the unit boundary, and no closer than 200 feet from the unit boundaries where 10-acre density drilling has not been allowed, without exception being granted by the Director of the Commission.

- 4. That Applicant has drilled, tested and completed multiple wells in the Williams Fork and Iles Formations of the Mesaverde Group upon the lands nearby to the Application Lands.
- 5. That to promote efficient drainage, and to address irregular sections, within the Williams Fork and Iles Formations of the Mesaverde Group of the Application Lands, the Commission should vacate Order No. 139-73 as to the Application Lands and increase the number of wells which can be optionally drilled into and produced from each of the Williams Fork and Iles Formations of the Mesaverde Group of the Application Lands to the equivalent of approximately one well per 9 acres.
- 6. That as to all future Williams Fork/lles wells to be drilled upon the Application Lands, each well may be located down hole anywhere upon such lands but no closer than one hundred (100) feet from the lease line unless the line or boundary abuts or corners lands in respect of which the Commission has not at the time of the drilling permit application granted the right to drill ten (10) acre density wells, in which event the well shall be drilled down hole no closer than 200 feet from that portion of the lease line, if applicable which so abuts or corners the lands in respect of which ten (10) acre density down hole drilling for Williams Fork or lles wells has not been ordered by the Commission.
- 7. Applicant commits that wells to be drilled under this Application will be drilled from the surface either vertically or directionally from no more than one pad located on a given quarter quarter (or lots or parcels approximately equivalent thereto) section unless exception is granted by the Director of the Colorado Oil and Gas Conservation Commission, and that both the Williams Fork and Iles formations will be reached from a single wellbore, *i.e.*, separate wells will not be drilled to reach each formation. In this manner the wells will be economic as to both formations.
- 8. That the above-proposed density and well location rules will allow more efficient drainage of the Williams Fork and Iles Formations of the Mesaverde Group; will prevent waste; will not adversely effect correlative rights and will assure the greatest ultimate recovery of gas and associated hydrocarbon substances from the reservoir.
- 9. That the names and addresses of the interested parties according to the information and belief of the Applicant are set forth in <a href="Exhibit A">Exhibit A</a> attached hereto and

made a part hereof, and the undersigned certifies that copies of this Application shall be served on each interested party within the next seven days as required by Rule 503.d.

WHEREFORE, Applicant respectfully requests that this matter be set for hearing, that notice be given as required by law and that upon such hearing this Commission enter its order consistent with Applicant's proposals as set forth above.
