### **APPLICATION**

COMES NOW Williams Production RMT Company ("Applicant"), a Delaware corporation, by its attorneys, Beatty & Wozniak, P.C., and makes application to the Oil and Gas Conservation Commission of the State of Colorado for an order establishing spacing, well density and location rules applicable to the drilling and producing of wells from the Williams Fork Formation of the Mesaverde Group covering certain described lands in the South Grand Valley Field area in Garfield County and in support of its application states and alleges as follows:

- 1. That Applicant is a corporation duly authorized to conduct business in the State of Colorado.
- 2. That Applicant owns a leasehold interest in all or a substantial portion of following described lands:

### Township 7 South, Range 96 West, 6th P.M.

- Section 31: SE/4SE/4 approximate 40 acre spacing
- Section 32: E/2NE/4 approximate 80 acre spacing
- Section 32: W/2NE/4 approximate 80 acre spacing
- Section 32: E/2SE/4 approximate 80 acre spacing
- Section 32: NW/4SE/4 approximate 40 acre spacing
- Section 32: SW/4SE/4 approximate 40 acre spacing
- Section 32: SE/4NW/4 approximate 40 acre spacing
- Section 32: NE/4SW/4 approximate 40 acre spacing
- Section 32: SE/4SW/4 approximate 40 acre spacing
- Section 32: SW/4SW/4 approximate 40 acre spacing
- Section 33: N/2NW/4 approximate 80 acre spacing
- Section 33: S/2NW/4 approximate 80 acre spacing
- Section 33: N/2SW/4 (aka NW/4SW/4 and Lot 3) approximate 80 acre spacing
- Section 33: SW/4SW/4 (aka part of Lot 9)- approximate 40 acre spacing
- Section 33: N/2NE/4 approximate 80 acre spacing
- Section 33: S/2NE/4 (aka Lots 1 and 2) approximate 80 acre spacing

(hereinafter "Application Lands")

- 3. That, as to the Williams Fork Formation, the Application Lands are unspaced but subject to the Commission's Order 510-1 which establishes setback requirements applicable to the drilling of Williams Fork wells.
- 4. That Applicant and others have drilled, tested and completed various wells in the Williams Fork Formation of the Mesaverde Group upon lands in the vicinity of the Application Lands.
- 5. That Applicant desires to establish drilling and spacing units for the production of gas and associated hydrocarbons from the Williams Fork Formation, such drilling and spacing units being set forth in paragraph 2 above.
- 6. That to promote efficient drainage within the Williams Fork Formation of the Mesaverde Group of the Application Lands, the Commission should increase the number of wells which can be optionally drilled into and produced from the Williams Fork Formation of each drilling unit proposed above to the equivalent of one Williams Fork well per 10 acres.
- 7. That Williams Fork Formation wells should be located downhole anywhere within a given drilling unit but no closer than 100 feet from the boundary or boundaries of the unit provided however that in cases where a unit abuts or corners lands in respect of which the Commission has not at the time of drilling permit application granted the right to drill 10 acre density Williams Fork Formation wells, the well should be located downhole within that unit no closer than 200 feet from the boundary or boundaries of such drilling unit so abutting or cornering such lands without exception being granted by the Director of the Oil and Gas Conservation Commission.
- 8. That the above-proposed spacing and well location rules will allow development of the Williams Fork Formation to occur; will not promote waste; will not violate correlative rights and will assure the greatest ultimate recovery of gas and associated hydrocarbon substances from the reservoir.
- 9. That the names and addresses of the interested parties according to the information and belief of the Applicant are set forth in <a href="Exhibit A">Exhibit A</a> attached hereto and made a part hereof.

WHEREFORE, Applicant respectfully requests that this matter be set for hearing in January 2009; that notice be given as required by law and that upon such hearing this Commission enter its order consistent with Applicant's proposals as set forth above.
