# BEFORE THE OIL AND GAS CONSERVATION COMMISSION OF THE STATE OF COLORADO

IN THE MATTER OF THE APPLICATION OF ANTERO RESOURCES PICEANCE CORPORATION FOR AN ORDER ESTABLISHING SPACING AND WELL LOCATION RULES FOR THE WILLIAMS FORK AND ILES FORMATIONS OF THE MESAVERDE GROUP FOR CERTAIN DESCRIBED LANDS IN THE PARACHUTE FIELD AREA, GARFIELD COUNTY, COLORADO

### **APPLICATION**

COMES NOW Antero Resources Piceance Corporation ("Applicant"), a Delaware corporation, by its attorneys, Beatty & Wozniak, P.C., and makes application to the Oil and Gas Conservation Commission of the State of Colorado for an order vacating an existing drilling and spacing unit and establishing spacing in two new drilling and spacing units and establishing well location rules applicable to the drilling and producing of wells from the Williams Fork and Iles Formations of the Mesaverde Group covering certain described lands in the Parachute Field area, Garfield County, Colorado and in support of its application states and alleges as follows:

- 1. That Applicant is a corporation duly authorized to conduct business in the State of Colorado.
- 2. That Applicant owns a leasehold interest in a substantial portion of the following described lands:

Township 7 South, Range 95 West, 6<sup>th</sup> P.M. Section 17: W/2 and W/2E/2

- 3. That, pursuant to the Commission's Order No. 440-12 dated May 18, 1990, certain described sections including Section 17 of Township 7 South, Range 95 West, 6<sup>th</sup> P.M., were established as 320 acre drilling and spacing units for the production of gas and associated hydrocarbons from the Mesaverde Formation consisting of the E/2 and W/2 or the N/2 and S/2 of the section with the operator of the first well permitted in a section to designate the drilling unit with the permitted well to be located on the established unit no closer than 600 feet from the boundaries of the unit and no closer than 1200 feet from any well producing or producible from the same formation.
- 4. That, pursuant to the Commission's Order No. 440-48 dated August 28, 2007, the drilling and spacing unit consisting of the E/2 of Section 17 in Township 7 South, Range 95 West, 6<sup>th</sup> P.M. was vacated as it applied to both the Williams Fork and Iles Formations and four approximate 40 acre drilling and spacing units consisting of the E/2E/2 of said Section 17 were established for the Williams Fork and Iles Formations with twenty (20) acre density drilling being permitted thereon for such formations.

5. To the extent that the W/2 of Section 17 continues to be a 320 acre drilling and spacing unit for the Williams Fork and Iles Formation, Applicant desires to vacate same and to establish two new approximate 240 acre drilling and spacing units for the production of gas and associated hydrocarbons from the Williams Fork and Iles Formations, each such drilling and spacing unit described as follows:

Township 7 South, Range 95 West, 6th P.M.

Section 17: NW/4 and W/2NE/4 Section 17: SW/4 and W/2SE/4

(hereinafter Application Lands)

- 6. That multiple wells have been drilled, tested and completed in the Williams Fork and lles Formations of the Mesaverde Group upon lands in the immediate vicinity of the Application Lands.
- 7. That as to all future Williams Fork wells to be drilled upon the Application Lands within each drilling and spacing unit, the well should be located downhole anywhere in the drilling and spacing unit but no closer than 100 feet from the boundaries of the unit without exception being granted by the Director of the Oil and Gas Conservation Commission. It is provided however that in cases where the Application Lands abut or corner lands in respect of which the Commission has not at the time of drilling permit application granted the right to drill optional 10 acre density Williams Fork Wells, the well should be located downhole no closer than 200 feet from the boundary or boundaries of the drilling unit so abutting or cornering such lands without exception being granted by the Director of the Oil and Gas Conservation Commission.
- 8. That as to all future lles wells to be drilled upon the Application Lands within each drilling and spacing unit, the well should be located downhole anywhere in the drilling and spacing unit but no closer than 100 feet from the boundaries of the unit without exception being granted by the Director of the Oil and Gas Conservation Commission. It is provided however that in cases where the Application Lands abut or corner lands in respect of which the Commission has not at the time of drilling permit application granted the right to drill optional 10 acre density lles Wells, the well should be located downhole no closer than 200 feet from the boundary or boundaries of the drilling unit so abutting or cornering such lands without exception being granted by the Director of the Oil and Gas Conservation Commission.
- 9. That, except as previously authorized by order of the Commission, wells to be drilled under this application will be drilled from the surface either vertically or directionally from no more than one pad located on a given quarter quarter section (or lots or parcels approximately equivalent thereto) unless exception is granted by the Director of the Colorado Oil and Gas Conservation Commission pursuant to application made for such exception.
- 10. The granting of this application will not promote waste; will not violate correlative rights and will assure the greatest ultimate recovery of gas and associated hydrocarbon substances from the reservoir.
- 11. That the names and addresses of the interested parties according to the information and belief of the Applicant are set forth in Exhibit A attached hereto and made a part hereof.

WHEREFORE, Applicant respectfully requests that this matter be set for hearing in July, 2009, that notice be given as required by law and that upon such hearing this Commission enter its order consistent with Applicant's proposals as set forth above.
