COMES NOW Bill Barrett Corporation ("Applicant"), a Delaware corporation, by its attorneys, Beatty & Wozniak, P.C., and makes this application to the Oil and Gas Conservation Commission of the State of Colorado for an order establishing spacing rules applicable to the drilling and producing of wells from the Iles Formation of the Mesaverde Group covering certain described lands in the Mamm Creek Field area in Garfield County, Colorado and in support of its application states and alleges as follows:

- 1. That Applicant is a corporation duly authorized to conduct business in the State of Colorado.
- 2. That Applicant is the operator of a certain federal exploratory unit known as the Gibson Gulch II Unit, approved on September 13, 1990 by the Bureau of Land Management, consisting of the following described lands:

Township 6 South, Range 91 West, 6th P.M.

Section 19: SE/4NW/4, SW/4NE/4, S/2

Section 20: S/2

Section 21: W/2SW/4

Section 28: W/2, W/2SE/4

Section 29: All

Section 30: All

Section 31: N/2, N/2SW/4, SE/4

Section 32: N/2. N/2S/2. S/2SW/4, SW/4SE/4

Section 33: N/2NW/4, SW/4NW/4

(hereinafter "Application Lands")

3. Under the Commission's Rule 318(d)(3), the well location rules otherwise applicable under Rule 318 do not apply to unit operations approved by federal authorities except that no well in excess of two thousand five hundred (2,500) feet in depth shall be located less than six hundred (600) feet in depth from the exterior or interior (if there be one) boundary of the unit area unless otherwise authorized by the order of the Commission after proper notice to owners outside the unit area.

- 4. Pursuant to Order No. 191-9 (Corrected) dated February 14, 2005, Rule 318 (d)(3) was amended to allow Williams Fork wells as to the Application Lands to be located downhole anywhere within the Gibson Gulch II Unit but no closer than 100 feet from the boundaries of the exterior or interior (if applicable) boundary unless such boundary abuts or corners lands in respect of which the Commission has not at the time of drilling permit application granted the right to drill 10 acre density Williams Fork Formation wells in which event the wells shall be located downhole no closer than 200 feet from such exterior or interior (as applicable) boundary unless exception is granted by the Commission.
- 5. Applicant and others have drilled, tested and completed wells in the lles Formation of the Mesaverde Group within the area of the Application Lands and other nearby lands.
- 6. That to promote efficient drainage within the lles Formation of the Mesaverde Group of the Application Lands, the Commission should establish new setback rules applicable to the drilling of lles wells within the Gibson Gulch II Unit area comprised of the Application Lands such that an Iles Formation well should be located downhole anywhere upon the Application Lands but no closer than 100 feet from the boundaries of the exterior or interior (if applicable) boundary unless such boundary abuts or corners lands in respect of which the Commission has not at the time of drilling permit application granted the right to drill 10 acre density Williams Fork wells in which event the wells should be located downhole no closer than 200 feet from the exterior or interior (as applicable) boundary unless exception is granted by the Director of the commission.
- 7. That the above-proposed well location rules will allow more efficient drainage of the lles Formation of the Mesaverde Group; will not promote waste; will not violate correlative rights and will assure the greatest ultimate recovery of gas and associated hydrocarbon substances from the reservoir.
- 8. That the names and addresses of the interested parties according to the information and belief of the Applicant are set forth in Exhibit A attached hereto and made a part hereof.

WHEREFORE, Applicant respectfully requests that this matter be set for hearing in June, 2009, that notice be given as required by law and that upon such hearing this Commission enter its order consistent with Applicant's proposals as set forth above.
