Dear Ms. Humecki:

This is in reference to complaint # 200258755, and the resulting report from the COGCC. The complaint alleged that my domestic water well was impacted by the hydraulic fracturing of the Alibi 23-2 CBM well. The complaint was closed without any enforcement action. I am not satisfied with this finding.

Acting on Rule 522.a(4), please consider this letter a formal application to the Commission for an Order Finding Violation, pursuant to Rule 503.b(4). I further call on the provisions of Rule 510, which provides any person the opportunity to make a statement at any Commission hearing. I am requesting a hearing before the Commissioners on February 22. A signed original and 13 copies will be mailed out soon.

I request that I be given a minimum of 30 uninterrupted minutes to present my case; one hour total including dialog with the Commissioners. I will be referencing not only this most recent impact to my water well, but the whole series of impacts we have experienced here on the North Fork Ranch as background material.

I will not be employing an attorney, nor will I be utilizing technical experts in presenting my case before the Commission. My argument will employ appropriate scientific reasoning and provide supporting documentation to the extent practicable. I will utilize a PowerPoint presentation to make my case, accompanied by a written statement. A CD of the PowerPoint presentation and 14 copies of the written statement will be sent to the COGCC on February 1st, 2011.
