APPLICATION

Encana Oil and Gas (USA) Inc. ("Applicant"), by and through its attorneys, Beatty & Wozniak, P.C., respectfully submits this Application to the Colorado Oil and Gas Conservation Commission ("Commission") for an order establishing well location and setback rules applicable to the drilling and producing of wells from the Williams Fork Formation covering certain described lands in Garfield County, Colorado and in support of its application states and alleges as follows:

1. Applicant is a corporation duly authorized to conduct business in the State of Colorado.
2. Applicant owns a leasehold interest in all or a substantial portion of the following described lands (hereinafter "Application Lands"):

Township 7 South, Range 94 West, 6th P.M.

Section 1: All
Section 2: All
Section 10: All
Section 13: Lot 1, NWNE, N2NW
Section 24: Lots 1, 2 and 3

Garfield County, Colorado

A reference map is attached hereto.

3. Commission Order No. 139-50, the most recent order applying to Sections 1, 2, and 10 of the Application Lands, allowed the equivalent of one (1) Williams Fork and Iles Formation well per twenty (20) acres, or thirty two (32) wells for each six hundred forty (640) acre drilling and spacing unit, may be drilled with each well located no closer than two hundred (200) feet from the boundaries of the unit and no closer than four hundred (400) feet from any existing Williams Fork and Iles Formation well without exception being granted by the Director of the Commission. Order No. 139-50 further provided that wells shall be drilled from the surface either vertically or directionally from no more than one well pad located on a given quarter-quarter section unless exception is granted by the Director of the Commission and that both the Williams Fork and Iles Formations shall be reached from a single wellbore, i.e., separate wells shall not be drilled to reach each formation.
4. Commission Order No. 139-85, established, among other things, that the equivalent of one (1) well per ten (10) acres may be drilled on portions of Sections 13 and 24 for the production of gas and associated hydrocarbons from the Williams Fork Formation. Order No. 139-85 further ordered that all Williams Fork Formation wells drilled on the lands shall be located downhole anywhere upon such lands no closer than one hundred (100) feet from the outside boundary of the Application Lands unless such unit abuts or corners lands that Commission has not, at the time of the drilling permit application, granted the right to drill ten (10) acre density downhole drilling for the Williams Fork Formation, in which event the Williams Fork Formation wells to be drilled upon portions of Sections 13 and 24 shall be drilled downhole no closer than two hundred (200) feet from the portion of the boundary which abuts or corners the lands in respect of which ten (10) acre density downhole drilling for the Williams Fork Formation wells has not been ordered by the Commission. Commission Order No. 139-85 does not apply to Sections 13 and 24 of the Application Lands, but is listed here to illustrate that the Commission has approved 10-acre density in other portions of Sections 13 and 24.
5. Commission Order No. 139-100 established, among other things, that the equivalent of one (1) well per ten (10) acres is allowed for the production of gas and associated hydrocarbons from the Williams Fork and Iles Formations from a portion of Section 13. Order 139-100 further ordered that wells drilled shall be located downhole anywhere within the lands but

no closer than one hundred (100) feet from a lease line or the boundaries of the Application Lands without exception being granted by the Director of the Commission. Where Section 13 abuts or corners lands which the Commission has not, at the time of drilling permit application, granted the right to drill ten (10) acre density Williams Fork Formation wells, the well shall be located downhole no closer than two hundred (200) feet from the boundary or boundaries of Section 13 Lands, without exception being granted by the Director of the Commission. Commission Order No. 139-100 does not apply to Section 13 of the Application Lands, but is listed here to illustrate that the Commission has approved 10-acre density on other portions of Section 13.

6. Commission Order No. 139-92 established, among other things, that the equivalent of one (1) well per ten (10) acres is allowed for the production of gas and associated hydrocarbons from the Williams Fork and Iles Formations for a portion of Section 24. Order No. 139-92 further ordered that Williams Fork Formation and Iles Formation wells drilled on the lands shall be located downhole anywhere upon such lands but no closer than one hundred (100) feet from a lease line or the boundaries of Section 24, without exception being granted by the Director of the Commission. In cases where the lands abut or corners lands which the Commission has not, at the time of drilling permit application, granted the right to drill ten (10) acre density wells, the well shall be located downhole no closer than two hundred (200) feet from the boundary or boundaries of Section 24 without exception being granted by the Director of the Commission. Order No. 139-92 further ordered that all Williams Fork Formation and Iles Formation wells drilled upon the lands shall be drilled from the surface either vertically or directionally from no more than one (1) pad located on a given quarter-quarter section (or lots or parcels approximately equivalent thereto) unless exception is granted by the Director Commission. Commission Order No. 139-92 does not apply to Section 24 of the Application Lands, but is listed here to illustrate that the Commission has approved 10-acre density in other portions of Section 24.

7. Commission Rule 318.a. applies to Sections 13 and 24 of the Application Lands because they are unspaced. Rule 318.a. provides that a well to be drilled to two thousand five hundred (2,500) feet or greater shall be located not less than six hundred (600) feet from any lease line, and shall be located not less than one thousand two hundred (1,200) feet from any other producible or drilling oil or gas well when drilling to the same common source of supply, unless authorized by order of the Commission upon hearing.

8. Applicant asserts that multiple wells have been drilled upon lands adjacent to or in close proximity to the Application Lands with the result that geological and engineering evidence indicates that Williams Fork wells in the Mesaverde Group on the Application Lands now should be allowed to be drilled on a ten (10) acre density basis.

9. Applicant requests that the Commission allow Williams Fork wells in the Mesaverde Group to be optionally drilled upon the Application Lands on a ten (10) acre density basis with each such well to be located downhole anywhere within the Application Lands provided no such wells shall be located downhole any closer than one hundred (100) feet from the boundary of any established unit or section line unless such boundary abuts or corners lands which the Commission has not, at the time of the drilling permit application, granted the right to drill ten (10) acre density Williams Fork Formation wells. In such an event, Williams Fork Formation wells to be drilled upon the given drilling and spacing unit or section shall be drilled downhole no closer than two hundred (200) feet from that portion of the unit boundary or section line which so abuts or corners the lands in respect of which ten (10) acre density downhole drilling for Williams Fork Formation wells has not been ordered by the Commission.

10. Applicant requests that this Commission allow wells drilled under this Application to be drilled from the surface either vertically or directionally from no more than one (1) pad located on a given quarter-quarter section (or lots or parcels approximately equivalent thereto) unless exception is granted by the Commission pursuant to application made for such exception.

11. Applicant confirms that it is not requesting spacing for the Application Lands.

12. The above-proposed ten (10) acre density will allow development of the Williams Fork Formation to occur, will prevent waste, will protect correlative rights, and will assure the greatest ultimate recovery of gas and associated hydrocarbon substances from the reservoir.

13. That the names and addresses of the interested parties according to the information and belief of the Applicant are set forth in Exhibit A attached hereto and made a part hereof.

WHEREFORE, Applicant respectfully requests that this matter be set for hearing at the next regular hearing date; that notice be given as required by law and that upon such hearing this Commission enter its order:

A. Allowing Williams Fork wells in the Mesaverde Group to be optionally drilled upon the Application Lands on a ten (10) acre density basis with each such well to be located downhole anywhere within the Application Lands provided no such wells shall be located downhole any closer than one hundred (100) feet from the boundary of any established unit or section line unless such boundary abuts or corners lands which the Commission has not, at the time of the drilling permit application, granted the right to drill ten (10) acre density Williams Fork Formation wells. In such an event, Williams Fork Formation wells to be drilled upon the given drilling and spacing unit or section shall be drilled downhole no closer than two hundred (200) feet from that portion of the unit boundary or section line which so abuts or corners the lands in respect of which ten (10) acre density downhole drilling for Williams Fork Formation wells has not been ordered by the Commission.;

B. Allow Williams Fork Formation wells in the Mesaverde Group on the Application Lands to be drilled from the surface either vertically or directionally from no more than one (1) pad located on a given quarter-quarter section (or lots or parcels approximately equivalent thereto) unless exception is granted by the Commission pursuant to application made for such exception;

C. Confirming that there will be no spacing on the unspaced areas of the Application Lands; and

D. Granting any other relief necessary to prevent waste and protect correlative rights of the owners.
