## BEFORE THE OIL AND GAS CONSERVATION COMMISSION OF THE STATE OF COLORADO

IN THE MATTER OF THE APPLICATION OF WPX CAUSE NO. ENERGY ROCKY MOUNTAIN, LLC FOR AN ORDER POOLING ALL INTERESTS IN THE WILLIAMS FORK | DOCKET NO. AND/OR ILES FORMATIONS IN TWO (2) 40 ACRE DRILLING AND SPACING UNITS IN WELD COUNTY, COLORADO

#### **APPLICATION**

COMES NOW WPX Energy Rocky Mountain, LLC ("Applicant"), by its attorneys, Beatty & Wozniak, P.C., and makes application to the Oil and Gas Conservation Commission of the State of Colorado ("Commission") for an order pooling all interests for the development of the Williams Fork and/or Iles Formations in the following two (2) 40 acre drilling and spacing units:

> Township 2 South, Range 98 West, 6th P.M Section 23: NW<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub>NW<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> - Drilling and Spacing Unit #1 Section 23: NE¼NW¼ - Drilling and Spacing Unit #2

Rio Blanco County, Colorado (hereinafter "Application Lands")

In support of its application, Applicant states and alleges as follows:

- Applicant is a limited liability corporation duly authorized to conduct business in the State of Colorado, and is a registered operator in good standing with the Commission.
  - Applicant owns leasehold interests in a substantial portion of the Application Lands. 2.
- The Application Lands are subject to a currently pending application filed by Application for an order establishing the two (2) 40 acre drilling and spacing units for the Application Lands as set forth above. Applicant has drilled the Federal RG 11-23-298 well in Drilling and Spacing Unit #1 and the Federal RG 321-23-298 well in Drilling and Spacing Unit #2.
- Applicant, pursuant to Commission Rule 530 and pursuant to the provisions of C.R.S. §34-60-116 (6) and (7), seeks an order to pool all interests, including but not limited to, any nonconsenting interests, in the Application Lands for the development of the Williams Fork and/or Iles Formations underlying Drilling and Spacing Unit #1 and Drilling and Spacing Unit #2.
- Applicant requests that the Commission's pooling order be made effective as of the date of this Application, or the date that the costs specified in C.R.S. § 34-60-116(7)(b)(II) are first incurred for the drilling of the any well to the Williams Fork and/or Iles Formations on the Application Lands, whichever is earlier.
- Applicant certifies that copies of this Application will be served on all persons owning an 6. interest in the mineral estate of the tracts to be pooled within seven (7) days of the date hereof, as required by Rule 507.b(2), and that at least thirty (30) days prior to the hearing on this matter, each such interest owner not already leased or voluntarily pooled will be, or has already been, offered the opportunity to lease, or to participate in the drilling of the well, and will be provided with the information required by Rule 530.

interested parties list shall be filed with the Commission no later than seven (7) days after the filing of this application.

7. That in order to prevent waste and to protect correlative rights, all interests in the Application Lands should be pooled for the orderly development of the Williams Fork and/or Iles Formations, including any nonconsenting interests therein.

WHEREFORE, Applicant requests that this matter be set for hearing at the next available opportunity, that notice be given as required by law, and that upon such hearing, the Commission enter its order:

- A. Pooling all interests in Drilling and Spacing Unit #1 and Drilling and Spacing Unit #2 for the development of the Williams Fork and Iles Formations.
- B. Providing that the Commission's pooling order is made effective as of the date of this Application, or the date that any of the costs specified in C.R.S. § 34-60-116(7)(b)(II) were first incurred for the drilling of a well in Drilling and Spacing Unit #1 and the drilling of a well in Drilling and Spacing Unit #2, whichever is earlier.
- C. Providing that the interests of any owners with whom the Applicant has been unable to secure a lease or other agreement to participate in the drilling of a well are pooled by operation of statute, pursuant to C.R.S. § 34-60-116(7), and made subject to the cost recovery provisions thereof with respect to all wells drilled to develop the Williams Fork and/or Iles Formations in Drilling and Spacing Unit #1 and Drilling and Spacing Unit #2 comprised of the Application Lands.
- D. For such other findings and orders as the Commission may deem proper or advisable in this matter.

WHEREFORE, Applicant respectfully requests that this matter be set for hearing in August, 2012, that notice be given as required by law, and that upon such hearing, the Commission enter its order consistent with Applicant's request as set forth above.




