APPLICATION

Carrizo Oil and Gas, Inc. ("Applicant"), by and through its attorneys, Beatty & Wozniak, P.C., respectfully submits this Application to the Oil and Gas Conservation Commission of the State of Colorado (the "Commission") for an order authorizing up to six horizontal wells in the following-described 1280-acre drilling and spacing unit:

Township 7 North, Range 60 West, 6th P.M.

Section 17: All Section 18: All

Weld County, Colorado ("Application Lands"),

and further providing that the treated interval of each horizontal wellbore may be separated by a minimum of 600 feet for the production of oil, gas and associated hydrocarbons from the Niobrara Formation.

In support of its Application, Applicant states and alleges as follows:

- 1. Applicant is a corporation duly authorized to conduct business in the State of Colorado and is an operator in good standing with the Commission.
 - 2. Applicant owns substantial leasehold interests in the Application Lands.
- 3. On June 27, 2011, the Commission entered Order No. 535-41 which, among other things, established nine approximate 640-acre drilling and spacing units for certain lands, including Section 18, Township 7 North, Range 60 West, and approved up to two horizontal wells within each unit for the production of oil, gas, and associated hydrocarbons from the Niobrara Formation.
- 4. On August 8, 2011 the Commission issued Order No. 535-65 which, among other things, established two approximate 640-acre drilling and spacing units for certain lands, including Section 17, Township 7 North, Range 60 West, and allowed up to two horizontal wells within each unit, for the production of oil, gas and associated hydrocarbons from the Niobrara Formation. This Order supersedes Order No. 535-51 which, among other things, established nine approximate 640-acre drilling and spacing units for certain lands, including Section 17, Township 7 North, Range 60 West, and approved up to one horizontal well within each unit.

- 5. On August 20, 2012 the Commission issued Order No. 535-195 which, among other things, established one 1,280-acre drilling and spacing unit, and allowed up to two horizontal wells on the Application Lands for the production of oil, gas and associated hydrocarbons from the Niobrara Formation.
- 6. Applicant requests that up to six horizontal wells be authorized for production of oil, gas and associated hydrocarbons from the Niobrara Formation in the Application Lands.
- 7. In accordance with Rule 318, Applicant will locate and drill the wells so that the treated interval of the horizontal wells is no closer than 600 feet from the boundaries of the units. Applicant requests that the 1,200 foot internal wellbore setback of Rule 318 be relaxed so that the treated interval of the horizontal wells may be separated by a minimum of 600 feet.
- 8. Applicant asserts that additional wells are necessary to prevent waste, protect correlative rights, and to assure the maximum efficient recovery of oil, gas and associated hydrocarbons from the Niobrara Formation on the Application Lands.
- 9. The names and addresses of the interested parties to this Application are set forth in Exhibit A, and the undersigned certifies that copies of this Application shall be served on each interested party as required by Rule 503.e.

WHEREFORE, Applicant respectfully requests that this matter be set for hearing, notice be given as required by law and that upon such hearing this Commission enter its order:

- A. Authorizing up to six horizontal wells in the Application Lands for production of oil, gas and associated hydrocarbons from the Niobrara Formation.
- B. Providing that said wells shall be located and drilled so that the treated interval of the wellbores are no closer than 600 feet from the boundaries of the unit and are separated by a minimum of 600 feet.

C. For such other findings and orders as the Commission may deem proper or advisable in the matter.


