APPLICATION

COMES NOW Condor Energy Technology, LLC ("Applicant"), by its attorneys, Beatty & Wozniak, P.C., and makes application to the Colorado Oil and Gas Conservation Commission ("Commission"), for an order to vacate the pooling Order No. 535-520 and re-pool all interests within a 640-acre exploratory drilling and spacing unit for the Well in the Niobrara Formation, located in the following described lands:

Township 7 North, Range 60 West, 6th P.M. Section 15: All

Weld County, Colorado ("Application Lands").

In support thereof, the Applicant states and alleges as follows:

- 1. Applicant is a limited liability company duly authorized to conduct business in the State of Colorado; and is a registered operator in good standing with the Commission.
 - 2. Applicant owns certain leasehold interests in the Application Lands.
- 3. On January 7, 2013, the Commission issued Order No. 535-242, which among other things established an approximate 1280-acre exploratory drilling and spacing unit for the below described lands, and to approved up to eight horizontal wells within the unit, for production of oil, gas and associated hydrocarbons from the Niobrara Formation:

Township 7 North, Range 60 West, 6th P.M.

Section 15: All Section 16: All

The Application Lands, however, are subject to an application requesting an order to vacate Order No. 535-242 and establish a 640-acre exploratory drilling and spacing unit filed by Applicant concurrently with this Application.

4. On January 7, 2013, the Commission issued Order No. 535-250, which among other things, pooled all interests in a 1280-acre unit for the State 16-7-60 1H Well, now known as the

Waves 15-1H ("Well")(No API No. as of the date of this filing), in the following exploratory drilling and spacing unit:

Township 7 North, Range 60 West, 6th P.M.

Section 15: All Section 16: All

- 5. Applicant hereby requests that Order No. 535-250 (pooling) be vacated as to the 1280-acre exploratory drilling and spacing unit established by Order No. 535-242 (spacing).
- 6. Applicant further requests that the Commission enter an order to re-pool all interests in the following modified 640-acre exploratory drilling and spacing unit for the Waves 15-1H Well and all subsequent wells for the development of the Niobrara Formation underlying the Application Lands:

Township 7 North, Range 60 West, 6th P.M.

Section 15: All

("Modified Exploratory Drilling and Spacing Unit").

- 7. Applicant requests that the Commission's order be made effective as of the earlier of (i) the date of this Application, or (ii) the date that the costs specified in C.R.S. § 34-60-116(7)(b)(II) are first incurred for the drilling of the Waves 15-1H Well and all subsequent wells to the Niobrara Formation on the Application Lands.
- 8. Applicant certifies that copies of this Application will be served on all persons owning an interest in the mineral estate of the tracts to be pooled within seven (7) days of the date hereof, as required by Rule 507.b(2). The list of such interested parties is attached hereto as Exhibit A.
- 9. That in order to prevent waste and to protect correlative rights, all interests in the Modified Exploratory Drilling and Spacing Unit on the Application Lands should be pooled for the orderly development of the Niobrara Formation, including any nonconsenting interests therein.

WHEREFORE, Applicant requests that this matter be set for hearing at the next available opportunity, that notice be given as required by law, and that upon such hearing, the Commission enter its order:

- A. Vacating Order No. 535-250.
- B. Re-pooling all interests in the Application Lands, and the Modified Exploratory Drilling and Spacing Unit for the Well and all subsequent wells, for the development of the Niobrara Formation.
- C. Providing that the Commission's order is made effective as of the earlier of (i) the date of this Application, or (ii) the date that the costs specified in C.R.S. § 34-60-116(7)(b)(II) are first incurred for the drilling of the Well to the Niobrara Formation on the Application Lands.

- D. Providing that the interests of any owners with whom the Applicant has been unable to secure a lease or other agreement to participate in the drilling of the Well are pooled by operation of statute, pursuant to C.R.S. § 34-60-116(7), and made subject to the cost recovery provisions thereof.
- E. For such other findings and orders as the Commission may deem proper or advisable in this matter.

WHEREFORE, Applicant respectfully requests that this matter be set for hearing in May, 2013, that notice be given as required by law, and that upon such hearing, the Commission enter its order consistent with Applicant's request as set forth above.
