#### **AMENDED APPLICATION**

Carrizo Oil and Gas, Inc. ("Applicant"), by and through its attorneys, Beatty & Wozniak, P.C., respectfully submits this Application to the Oil and Gas Conservation Commission of the State of Colorado (the "Commission") for an order 1) vacating parts of a certain pending Order issued on February 1, 2013 Order No \_\_\_\_\_ and Order No. 535-99, and 2) establishing one 960-acre exploratory drilling and spacing unit and one 320-acre exploratory drilling and spacing unit for the below-described lands for the development of the Niobrara Formation:

Township 10 North, Range 59 West, 6th P.M.

Section 27: All

the State of Colorado.

Section 28: E/2 ("DSU #1" approx. 960 acres)

Township 10 North, Range 59 West, 6<sup>th</sup> P.M. Section 33: E/2 ("DSU #2 approx. 320 acres)

Section 33. E/Z = (D30 # Z approx. 320 acres)

- 1. Applicant is a limited liability company duly authorized to conduct business in
  - 2. Applicant holds the right to operate on the Application Lands.

Weld County, Colorado (together, the "Application Lands").

- 3. The Application Lands are subject to Commission Rule 318.a. which provides that a well to be drilled in excess of two thousand five hundred (2,500) feet in depth shall be located not less than six hundred (600) feet from any lease line, and shall be located not less than one thousand two hundred (1,200) feet from any other producible or drilling oil or gas well when drilling to the same source of supply, unless authorized by order of the Commission upon hearing.
- 4. On December 12, 2011, the Commission issued Order No. 535-99 which, among other things, established one approximate 640-acre drilling and spacing unit and authorized two horizontal wells within the unit for the development of oil, gas, and other

hydrocarbons underlying the Niobrara Formation. Section 27, Township 10 North, Range 59 West, 6<sup>th</sup> P.M. is subject to this Order.

- 5. On May 29, 2012, the Commission issued Order No. 535-159 which, among other things, pooled all interests in the applicable 640-acre drilling and spacing unit pursuant C.R.S. 34-60-116 for the production of oil, gas, and associated hydrocarbons from the Niobrara Formation. Section 27, Township 10 North, Range 59 West, 6<sup>th</sup> P.M. is subject to this Order.
- **6.4.** On **February 1**, 2013, the Commission issued a **spacing** Order which, among other things, established three approximate 640-acre exploratory drilling units for the development of oil, gas, and other hydrocarbons underlying the Niobrara Formation. Sections 28 and 33, Township 10 North, Range 59 West, 6<sup>th</sup> P.M. are subject to this pending Order.
- 7. Applicant hereby requests that the Commission vacate Order No. 535-99 as it applies to Section 27, Township 10 North, Range 59 West, 6<sup>th</sup> P.M.
- **8.5.** Applicant hereby further requests that the Commission vacate said pending spacing Order, issued on February 1, 2013, No. \_\_\_\_\_as it applies to Sections 28 and 33, Township 10 North, Range 59 West, 6<sup>th</sup> P.M.
- 9.6. Applicant also requests that the Commission establish a 960-acre exploratory drilling and spacing unit comprised of the Application Lands described herein as DSU #1 and initially authorize one horizontal well within the unit.
- **10.7.** Applicant further requests that the Commission establish a 320-acre exploratory drilling and spacing unit comprised of the Application Lands described herein as DSU #2 and initially authorize one horizontal well within the unit.
- 11.8. That the above-proposed exploratory drilling and spacing units will facilitate efficient drainage of the Niobrara Formation thereby preventing waste, consistent with the correlative rights of the owners in the units. The drilling and spacing units of the size and shape specified above is not smaller than the maximum area that can be economically and efficiently drained by the proposed well in each drilling and spacing unit.
- **12.9.** Applicant states that the proposed horizontal well shall be located no closer than 600 feet from the boundaries of the unit for the development and production of oil, gas, and other associated hydrocarbons from the Niobrara formation.
- **13.**40. The undersigned certifies that copies of this Application will be served on each interested party within seven (7) days of the filing hereof, as required by Rule 503.e.

WHEREFORE, Applicant respectfully requests that this matter be set for hearing at the next available opportunity, that notice be given as required by law, and that upon such hearing this Commission enter its order:

A. Vacating Order No. 535-99 as it applies to Section 27, Township 10 North, Range 59 West, 6<sup>th</sup> P.M.

- B<sub>-</sub>A. Vacating **that certain pending** Order **issued February 1, 2013** as it applies to Sections 28 and 33, Township 10 North, Range 59 West, 6<sup>th</sup> P.M.
- C.B. Establishing the Application Lands as one approximate 960-acre exploratory drilling unit and one approximate 320-acre exploratory drilling unit for the Niobrara Formation and authorizing one horizontal well within each unit.
- **D.C.** Providing that the treated interval of the proposed horizontal well shall be no closer than 600 feet from the boundaries of the units for the development of the Niobrara Formation.
- **E.**D. For such other findings and orders as the Commission may deem proper or advisable in this matter.

WHEREFORE, Applicant respectfully requests that this matter be set for hearing in May 2013, that notice be given as required by law, and that upon such hearing, the Commission enter its order consistent with Applicant's request as set forth above.
