APPLICATION

COMES NOW PDC Energy, Inc. ("Applicant"), by its attorneys, Beatty & Wozniak. P.C., and makes this application to the Oil and Gas Conservation Commission of the State of Colorado ("Commission") for an order to affirm Order No. 407-656 as to all previously unnoticed interests in the following 160-acre designated wellbore spacing unit. Order No. 407-656 pooled all interests in the 160-acre wellbore spacing unit for the drilling of the Binder 10-OU Well (API No. 05-123-31021) ("Well") for the development of the Niobrara Formation underlying:

> Township 4 North, Range 67 West, 6th P.M. Section 10: SE1/4NW1/4, SW1/4NE1/4, NW1/4SE1/4, NE1/4SW1/4

Weld County, Colorado (hereinafter "Application Lands").

In support thereof, Applicant states and alleges as follows:

- Applicant is a corporation duly authorized to conduct business in the State of Colorado, and is a registered operator in good standing with the Commission.
- On February 19, 1992, the Commission issued Order No. 407-87 (amended August 20, 1993), which among other things, established 80-acre drilling and spacing units for the production of oil and/or gas from the Niobrara Formation underlying certain lands, including the Application Lands, with the permitted well locations in accordance with the provisions of Order No. 407-1.
- On April 27, 1998, the Commission adopted Rule 318A, which, among other things, allowed certain drilling locations to be utilized to drill or twin a well, deepen a well or recomplete a well and to commingle any or all of the Cretaceous Age Formations from the base of the Dakota Formation to the surface. On December 5, 2005, Rule 318A was amended to allow interior infill and boundary wells to be drilled and wellbore spacing units to be established. On August 8, 2011, Rule 318A was again amended to, among other things, address drilling of horizontal wells. The Application Lands are subject to Rule 318A for the Niobrara Formation.
- On March 30, 2012 (Amended April 4, 2012), Applicant filed an Application seeking an order to pool all interests in Application Lands and the Well for the development of the Niobrara Formation.

- 5. Applicant provided notice and offers to participate or lease to nonconsenting parties owning an interest in the Application Lands then known to Applicant, in accordance with Commission rules.
- 6. On May, 29, 2012, the Commission entered Order No. 407-656 which among other things established an approximate 160-acre designated wellbore spacing unit for the Application Lands and pooled all interests in said unit for the Well for the development and operation of the Niobrara Formation.
- 7. Since the entry of Order No. 407-339 on April 16⁻ 2012, Applicant has learned of additional interested parties within the Application Lands to whom notice of the March 30, 2012 application, as well as AFE's, election letters, or offers to lease have not been provided.
- 8. The grounds upon which Applicant originally sought the pooling order, and upon which Order No. 407-610 was entered, still apply to this Application. Specifically:
 - a) Applicant owns substantial leasehold interests in the Application Lands.
 - b) Applicant designated an approximate 160-acre wellbore spacing unit as defined below, for the production of oil, gas, and associated hydrocarbons from the Niobrara Formation pursuant to Rule 318A. and notified the appropriate parties under Rule 318A.
 - c) Applicant drilled the Well to produce oil and associated hydrocarbons from the Niobrara Formation underlying the Application Lands.
- 9. Applicant, pursuant to Commission Rule 530 and/or the provisions of C.R.S. § 34-60-116 (6) and (7), hereby requests an order to affirm Order No. 407-656 as to all previously unnoticed interests in the Application Lands for the development of the Niobrara Formation underlying the following approximate 160-acre designated wellbore spacing unit:

Township 4 North, Range 67 West, 6th P.M. Section 10: SE¼ NW¼, SW¼ NE¼, NW¼ SE¼, NE¼ SW¼

(hereafter, "the Wellbore Spacing Unit").

10. Applicant certifies that copies of this Application will be served on all previously unnoticed mineral interest owners in the tracts to be pooled within seven (7) days of the date hereof, as required by Rule 507.b(2), and that at least thirty (30) days prior to the hearing on this matter, each such interest owner not already leased or voluntarily pooled will be offered the opportunity to lease, or to participate in the drilling of the Well, and will be provided with the information required by Rule 530 as applicable. The list of such interested parties is attached hereto as Exhibit A.

WHEREFORE, Applicant requests that this matter be set for hearing at the next available opportunity, that notice be given as required by law, and that upon such hearing, the Commission enter its order:

A. Affirming Order No. 407-656 as to all previously unnoticed interests in the Application Lands and the Wellbore Spacing Unit for the development of the Niobrara Formation

so that it applies to all interest in the Application Lands, including said previously unnoticed interest owners.

B. For such other findings and orders as the Commission may deem proper or advisable in this matter.

WHEREFORE, Applicant respectfully requests that this matter be set for hearing in September, 2013, that notice be given as required by law, and that upon such hearing, the Commission enter its order consistent with Applicant's request as set forth above.
