APPLICATION

Extraction Oil & Gas, LLC ("Extraction" or "Applicant"), by its attorneys, Welborn Sullivan Meck & Tooley, P.C., respectfully submits this Application to the Oil and Gas Conservation Commission of the State of Colorado ("Commission" or "COGCC") for an order pooling all interests in an approximate 1280-acre drilling and spacing unit established for Sections 6 and 7, Township 10 North, Range 61 West, 6th P.M., Weld County, Colorado for the development and production from the Codell Formation. In support thereof, the Applicant states as follows:

- 1. Applicant is a limited liability company duly authorized to conduct business in the State of Colorado.
- 2. Applicant owns a leasehold interest in the following lands ("Application Lands"):

Township 10 North, Range 61 West, 6th P.M.

Section 6: All

Section 7: All

Weld County, Colorado.

A reference map of the Application Lands is attached hereto.

1. On December 15, 2014, the Commission issued Order No. 535-595, which established a 1280-acre drilling and spacing unit for production of oil, gas, and associated hydrocarbons from the Codell Formation, allowed up to four horizontal wells within the unit, and required that the productive interval of each wellbore shall be no closer than 600 feet from the productive interval of any other wellbore producing from the Codell Formation and no closer than 300 feet from a unit boundary unless such boundary abuts or corners lands for which the Commission has not at the time of the drilling application granted the right to locate the productive interval of the wellbore no closer than 300 feet from a unit boundary, without exception being granted by the Director. The Application Lands are subject to this Order.

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- 2. Applicant plans to drill and complete the Carson #1 (API# Pending), Carson #2 (API# Pending), Carson #3 (API# Pending), and Carson #4 (API# Pending) wells (the "Wells"). The Wells have the following anticipated spud dates and surface locations:
 - a. Carson #1 Third Quarter 2015, and located 1000 feet FWL; 300 feet FSL in Section 7, Township 10 North, Range 61 West, 6th P.M.;
 - b. Carson #2 Third Quarter 2015, and located 1030 feet FWL; 300 feet FSL in Section 7, Township 10 North, Range 61 West, 6th P.M.;
 - c. Carson #3 Third Quarter 2015, and located 1342 feet FEL; 300 feet FSL in Section 7, Township 10 North, Range 61 West, 6th P.M.; and
 - d. Carson #4 Third Quarter 2015, and located 1312 feet FEL; 300 feet FSL in Section 7, Township 10 North, Range 61 West, 6th P.M.;
- 3. The above-described horizontal wells are designed to test and produce gas and associated substances from the Codell Formation underlying the Application Lands.
- 4. Pursuant to the relevant provisions of Section 34-60-116(6) & (7), C.R.S., and COGCC Rule 530, Applicant seeks an order pooling all interests in the Application Lands for the development and operation of the Codell Formation.
- 5. Applicant certifies that, at least 35 days prior to the date of the scheduled protest deadline for this Application, each owner which Applicant was able to locate, not already leased or voluntarily pooled, will be provided with the well proposals and information required by Rule 530 and tendered a reasonable offer to lease (if an unleased mineral owner), or participate and bear costs associated with the drilling and completion of the Wells.
- 6. Applicant requests that a pooling order be entered as a result of this Application and that it be made effective as of the earlier of the date of this Application, or the date costs specified in Section 34-60-116(7)(b)(II), C.R.S., are first incurred for the drilling of the Wells.
- 7. The granting of this Application would be in accord with the Oil and Gas Conservation Act, found at Section 34-60-101, *et seq.*, C.R.S., and Commission rules.
- 8. The names and addresses of the interested parties (persons who own an interest in the mineral estate of the tracts to be pooled, except owners of overriding royalty interest) are attached hereto and marked Exhibit A. Applicant certifies that copies of this Application will be served on all locatable interested parties within seven (7) days of the date hereof, as required by Commission Rule 507.b(2), and that at least thirty (35) days prior to the date of the scheduled protest deadline for this Application, each such owner not already leased or voluntarily pooled will be offered the opportunity to lease, or to participate in the drilling of the Wells, and will be provided with the information required by Rule 530.

WHEREFORE, Applicant respectfully requests that this matter be set for hearing, that notice be given as required by law and that upon such hearing this Commission enter its order:

- A. Pooling all interests in the Application Lands for the development and operation of the Codell Formation;
- B. Providing that the pooling order is made effective as of the date of this Application, or the date that the costs specified in Section 34-60-116(7)(b)(II), C.R.S., are first incurred for the drilling of a Codell Formation well on the Application Lands, whichever is earlier;
- C. Providing that the interests of any owners, with whom the Applicant has been unable to secure a lease or other agreement to participate in the drilling of the authorized wells, are pooled by operation of statute, pursuant to Section 34-60-116(7), C.R.S., and made subject to the cost recovery provisions thereof;
- D. For such other findings and orders as the Commission may deem proper or advisable in the premises.


