APPLICATION

Catamount Energy Partners LLC ("Catamount" or "Applicant"), Operator No. 10464, by and through its attorneys, Welborn Sullivan Meck & Tooley, P.C., respectfully submits this Application to the Oil and Gas Conservation Commission of the State of Colorado ("Commission" or "COGCC") for an order pooling all non-consenting interests in an approximate 320-acre drilling and spacing unit established in the N½ of Section 18U, Township 34 North, Range 6 West, N.M.P.M. (S.U.L.), La Plata County, Colorado for the development and production from the Fruitland coal seams. In support thereof, the Applicant states as follows:

- 1. Applicant is a corporation duly authorized to conduct business in the State of Colorado.
- 2. Applicant owns a leasehold interest in the following lands ("Application Lands"):

Township 34 North, Range 6 West, N.M.P.M. (S.U.L.) Section 18U: Lots 1, 2, E/2NW/4, NE/4 aka N½

La Plata County, Colorado.

A reference map of the Application Lands is attached hereto.

- 1. On June 17, 1988, the Commission issued Order No. 112-60, which established 320-acre drilling and spacing units for production of gas from the Fruitland coal seams, with the permitted well to be located no closer than 990 feet from any outer boundary of the unit, nor closer than 130 feet from any interior quarter section line. The Application Lands are subject to this Order.
- 2. On December 17, 1990, the Commission issued Order No. 112-85, which approved two field rules for all wells producing from the Dakota, Mesaverde, Fruitland Pictured Cliffs, and Fruitland Coal Formations to protect the health, safety, and welfare of the citizens in the area.

- 3. On December 9, 2008, the Commission issued Order No. 112-215, which allowed up to four (4) wells to be drilled in each 320-acre drilling and spacing units subject to the Order for the production of gas from the Fruitland coal seams, with the permitted wells to be located no closer than six hundred sixty (660) feet from the unit boundary, with no interior section line setback. The Order further requires that the wells drilled pursuant to this Order must comply with the provisions of the MOU between BP America Production Company and La Plata County. The Application Lands are subject to this Order.
- 4. On October 27, 2014, the Commission issued Order No. 112-244, which pooled all interests in an approximate 320-acre drilling and spacing unit established for the Application Lands for the development and operation of the Fruitland Coal Seams, effective as of the earlier date of the date of August 28, 2014, or the date that any of the costs specified in § 34-60-116(7), C.R.S., were first incurred for the drilling of the Lynch 34-6-18 #1 well (API# 05-067-09920).
- 5. Applicant plans to drill and complete the Lynch 34-6-18 #2 well (API# 05-067-09921) with an anticipated spud date in Third Quarter 2015, in the N½ of Section 18U, Township 34 North, Range 6 West, N.M.P.M. (S.U.L.), La Plata County, Colorado with a surface location of 1,734 feet FNL and 209 feet FWL in Lot 2 of Section 18U. The above-described well is designed to test and produce gas and associated substances from the Fruitland coal seams underlying the Application Lands.
- 6. Applicant certifies that, at least 35 days prior to the date of the scheduled protest deadline for this Application, each owner which Applicant was able to locate, not already leased or voluntarily pooled, will be provided with the well proposal and information required by Rule 530 and tendered a reasonable offer to lease (if an unleased mineral owner), or participate and bear costs associated with the drilling and completion of the Lynch 34-6-18 #2 well.
- 7. Applicant requests that a pooling order be entered as a result of this Application and that it be made effective as of the earlier of the date of this Application, or the date costs specified in Section 34-60-116(7)(b)(II), C.R.S., are first incurred for the drilling of the Lynch 34-6-18 #2 well.
- 8. The granting of this Application would be in accord with the Oil and Gas Conservation Act, found at Section 34-60-101, et seq., C.R.S., and Commission rules.
- 9. The names and addresses of the interested parties (persons who own an interest in the mineral estate of the tracts to be pooled, except owners of overriding royalty interest) are attached hereto and marked Exhibit A. Applicant certifies that copies of this Application will be served on all locatable interested parties within seven (7) days of the date hereof, as required by Commission Rule 507.b(2), and that at least thirty (35) days prior to the date of the scheduled protest deadline for this Application, each such owner not already leased or voluntarily pooled will be offered the opportunity to lease, or to participate in the drilling of the respective wells, and will be provided with the information required by Rule 530.

WHEREFORE, Applicant respectfully requests that this matter be set for hearing, that notice be given as required by law and that upon such hearing this Commission enter its order:

- A. Providing that the pooling order is made effective as of the date of this Application, or the date that the costs specified in Section 34-60-116(7)(b)(II), C.R.S., are first incurred for the drilling of the Applicant's proposed Lynch 34-6-18 #2 well on the Application Lands, whichever is earlier;
- B. Providing that the interests of any owners, with whom the Applicant has been unable to secure a lease or other agreement to participate in the drilling of the Lynch 34-6-18 #2 well, are pooled by operation of statute, pursuant to Section 34-60-116(7), C.R.S., and made subject to the cost recovery provisions thereof; and
- C. For such other findings and orders as the Commission may deem proper or advisable in the premises.
