AMENDED APPLICATION

Bill Barrett Corporation, Operator No. 10071 ("BBC" or "Applicant"), by and through its attorneys, Beatty & Wozniak, P.C., respectfully submits this AMENDED Application ("AMENDED APPLICATION") to the Oil and Gas Conservation Commission of the State of Colorado ("Commission") for an order to: (1) establish an approximate 1,920-acre unconventional resource unit for Sections 10, 11 and 14, Township 6 North, Range 62 West, 6th P.M., for the production of oil, gas and associated hydrocarbons from the Codell and Niobrara Formations; (2) PROVISIONALLY MAINTAIN THE APPROXIMATE 640-ACRE DRILLING AND SPACING UNITS ESTABLISHED FOR SECTIONS 10, 11 AND 14, TOWNSHIP 6 NORTH, RANGE 62 WEST, 6TH P.M. BY ORDER NOS. 407-779 AND 535-4 FOR EXISTING PRODUCTION FROM THE NIOBRARA FORMATION; (3) PROVISIONALLY MAINTAIN AN APPROXIMATE 1,280-ACRE DRILLING AND SPACING UNIT ESTABLISHED FOR SECTIONS 11 AND 14, TOWNSHIP 6 NORTH, RANGE 62 WEST, 6TH P.M. BY ORDER NO. 407-943, FOR EXISTING PRODUCTION FROM THE NIOBRARA FORMATION; (4) vacate Order Nos. 407-822 and 535-382; (5) PROVISIONALLY MAINTAIN POOLING ORDER NOS. 407-811, 535-360, AND 407-915 FOR EXISTING PRODUCTION FROM THE NIOBRARA FORMATION; and (6) vacate an approximate 1,280-acre drilling and spacing unit established for Sections 11 and 14, Township 6 North, Range 62 West, 6th P.M. by Order No. 407-943 for production from the Codell Formation.

In support of its **AMENDED APPLICATION**, Applicant states and alleges as follows:

1. Applicant is a corporation duly authorized to conduct business in the State of Colorado, and has registered as an operator with the Commission.

2. Applicant owns substantial leasehold interests in the below-listed lands:

Township 6 North, Range 62 West, 6th P.M.

Section 10: All Section 11: All Section 14: All

1,920-acres, more or less, Weld County, Colorado

These lands are hereinafter referred to as the "Application Lands." A map depicting the acreage comprising the Application Lands is attached hereto and marked as <u>Exhibit A</u>.

3. On April 27, 1998, the Commission adopted Rule 318A. which, among other things, allowed certain drilling locations to be utilized to drill or twin a well, deepen a well or recomplete a well and to commingle any or all Cretaceous Age Formations from the base of the Dakota Formation to the surface. Rule 318A. supersedes all prior Commission drilling and spacing orders affecting well location and density requirements of Greater Wattenberg Area wells. On December 5, 2005, Rule 318A. was amended, among other things, to allow interior infill and boundary wells to be drilled and wellbore spacing units to be established. On August 8, 2011, Rule 318A. was again amended, among other things, to address drilling of horizontal wells. The Application Lands are subject to certain aspects of this rule for the Codell and Niobrara Formations.

Existing Commission Orders

- 4. On or about February 22, 2011, the Commission entered Order Nos. 407-779 and 535-4 (corrected April 4, 2013) which, among other things, established 640-acre drilling and spacing units for certain lands, including Sections 10, 11 and 14, Township 6 North, Range 62 West, 6th P.M., and approved one horizontal well for each unit, for production of oil, gas and associated hydrocarbons from the Niobrara Formation.
- 5. On or about July 29, 2013, the Commission entered Order Nos. 407-822 and 535-382 which, among other things, authorized an additional seven (7) horizontal wells, for a total of eight (8) horizontal wells, within the 640-acre drilling and spacing unit established for Section 10, Township 6 North, Range 62 West, 6th P.M., for production of oil, gas and associated hydrocarbons from the Niobrara Formation, and established an approximate 640-acre drilling and spacing unit for said Section 10, and authorized up to four (4) horizontal wells within the unit for production of oil, gas and associated hydrocarbons from the Codell Formation.
- 6. On or about June 17, 2013, the Commission entered Order Nos. 407-811 and 535-360 which, among other things, pooled all interests in the approximate 640-acre drilling and spacing unit established for Section 14, Township 6 North, Range 62 West, 6th P.M.
- 7. On or about January 27, 2014, the Commission entered Order No. 407-915 which, among other things, pooled all interests in the approximate 640-acre drilling and spacing unit established for Section 10, Township 6 North, Range 62 West, 6th P.M.

8. On or about March 17, 2014, the Commission entered Order No. 407-943 which, among other things, established: (1) an approximate 1,280-acre drilling and spacing unit for Sections 11 and 14, Township 6 North, Range 62 West, 6th P.M. and approved up to sixteen (16) horizontal wells within the unit for production of oil, gas and associated hydrocarbons from the Niobrara Formation; and (2) an approximate 1,280-acre drilling and spacing unit for said Sections 11 and 14, and approved up to four (4) horizontal wells within the unit for production of oil, gas and associated hydrocarbons from the Codell Formation.

Existing Wells

- 9. BBC presently operates the Dutch Lake 08-10H Well (API No. 05-123-35000), spud on October 27, 2013, under Order No. 535-4 within Section 10, Township 6 North, Range 62 West, 6th P.M., with production from the Niobrara Formation.
- 10. BBC presently operates the Dutch Lake 09-11H Well (API No. 05-123-33450), spud on October 23, 2012, under Order No. 535-4 within Section 11, Township 6 North, Range 62 West, 6th P.M., with production from the Niobrara Formation.
- 11. BBC presently operates the Dutch Lake 12-14H Well (API No. 05-123-33954), spud on November 30, 2012, under Order No. 535-4 within Section 14, Township 6 North, Range 62 West, 6th P.M., with production from the Niobrara Formation.
- 12. BBC presently operates the Ruh 6-62-11-0461BH2 Well (API No. 05-123-39416), spud on November 21, 2014, under Order No. 407-943 within Sections 11 and 14, Township 6 North, Range 62 West, 6th P.M., with production from the Niobrara Formation.
- 13. THE DUTCH LAKE 08-10H WELL, THE DUTCH LAKE 09-11H WELL, THE DUTCH LAKE 12-14H WELL AND THE RUH 6-62-11-0461BH2 WELL ARE HEREINAFTER COLLECTIVELY REFERRED TO AS THE "EXISTING WELLS."
- 14. Applicant asserts that there are no currently producing vertical or directional wells within the Application Lands.

Treatment of Existing Commission Orders

- 15. APPLICANT REQUESTS THAT THE COMMISSION MAINTAIN ORDER NOS. 407-779, 407-943 AND 535-4 FOR THE EXISTING WELLS WITHIN THE APPLICATION LANDS, BUT ONLY UNTIL SUCH TIME AS APPLICANT VOLUNTARILY POOLS SUBSTANTIALLY ALL INTERESTS IN THE PROPOSED UNCONVENTIONAL RESOURCE UNIT, OR THE COMMISSION ENTERS AN ORDER POOLING ALL INTERESTS IN THE PROPOSED UNCONVENTIONAL RESOURCE UNIT PURSUANT TO §34-60-116(6) & (7), C.R.S AND RULE 530.
- 16. APPLICANT REQUESTS THE COMMISSION MAINTAIN POOLING ORDER NOS. 407-811, 535-360, AND 407-915, BUT ONLY UNTIL SUCH TIME AS

APPLICANT VOLUNTARILY POOLS SUBSTANTIALLY ALL INTERESTS IN THE PROPOSED UNCONVENTIONAL RESOURCE UNIT, OR THE COMMISSION ENTERS AN ORDER POOLING ALL INTERESTS IN THE PROPOSED UNCONVENTIONAL RESOURCE UNIT PURSUANT TO §34-60-116(6) & (7), C.R.S AND RULE 530.

- 17. Applicant requests that the Commission vacate Order Nos. 407-822 and 535-382.
- 18. Applicant further requests the Commission vacate Order No. 407-943 **AS TO THE CODELL FORMATION**.

<u>Establish an approximate 1,920-acre Unconventional Resource Unit for production from the Codell and Niobrara Formations</u>

- 19. Pursuant to applicable Colorado statutes and COGCC regulations, Applicant requests the Commission establish an approximate 1,920-acre unconventional resource unit for the Application Lands, for the production of oil, gas and associated hydrocarbons from the Codell and Niobrara Formations.
- 20. Applicant asserts that the proposed unconventional resource unit will promote efficient drainage of the Codell and Niobrara Formations, will prevent waste, will not adversely affect correlative rights, and will maximize the ultimate recovery of the resources underlying the Application Lands.
- 21. Applicant requests it be authorized to drill and complete the appropriate number of wells within the proposed unconventional resource unit in order to economically and efficiently recover the oil, gas and associated hydrocarbons from the proposed unit.
- 22. Applicant states that any wells to be drilled within the unconventional resource unit proposed herein will be drilled from no more than twelve (12) multi-well pads on the surface of the unconventional resource unit, or on adjacent lands with the consent of the landowner, without exception being granted by the Director.
- 23. Applicant further requests that, for any permitted wells to be drilled within the proposed unconventional resource unit, the treated intervals of the wellbore should be no closer than 300 feet from the unit boundaries, and not less than 150 feet from the productive interval of any other wellbore located in the unit, without exception being granted by the Director. Applicant maintains that the reduced setback will not violate the correlative rights of adjacent landowners, and will further prevent waste of the underlying resources.
- 24. Applicant requests that the Commission exclude all vertical or directional wells drilled and completed to the Codell and Niobrara Formations from the proposed unit. According to the records maintained by the COGCC, there are currently no producing vertical or directional wells within the Application Lands.

- APPLICANT STATES THAT PRODUCTION FROM THE EXISTING 25. WELLS DRILLED AND COMPLETED IN THE APPLICATION LANDS WILL CONTINUE TO BE ALLOCATED BASED ON THE PROVISIONALLY MAINTAINED DRILLING AND SPACING UNITS AND POOLING ORDERS UNTIL SUCH TIME AS THE APPLICANT OBTAINS A VOLUNTARY POOLING AGREEMENT OR POOLING THE **PROPOSED** UNCONVENTIONAL RESOURCE **FOR** APPLICANT ATTESTS THAT, UPON EXECUTION OF A VOLUNTARY AGREEMENT SUBSTANTIALLY ALL **INTERESTS** IN THE **PROPOSED POOLING** UNCONVENTIONAL RESOURCE UNIT, OR ENTRY OF AN ORDER POOLING ALL INTERESTS IN THE PROPOSED UNCONVENTIONAL RESOURCE UNIT. THE EXISTING WELLS WILL BE INCLUDED IN THE PROPOSED UNCONVENTIONAL RESOURCE UNIT, AND PRODUCTION FROM THE EXISTING WELLS WILL BE PROSPECTIVELY ALLOCATED THERETO.
- 26. The granting of this **AMENDED APPLICATION** is in accord with the Oil and Gas Conservation Act, found at §34-60-101, *et seq.*, C.R.S., and the Commission Rules.
- 27. Applicant requests that relief granted under this **AMENDED APPLICATION** should be effective on oral order by the Commission, and Applicant hereby agrees to being bound by said oral order.
- 28. That the names and addresses of the interested parties (owners within the proposed unconventional resource unit, owners of contiguous or cornering tracts who may be affected by the change in setbacks, and all persons who own any interest in the mineral estate of the pooled units who may be affected by the relief requested in the **AMENDED APPLICATION**, except owners of overriding royalty interest) according to the information and belief of the Applicant are set forth in <u>Exhibit B</u> attached hereto. The Applicant shall submit a certificate of service for the **AMENDED APPLICATION** within the seven days as required by Rule 503.e.

WHEREFORE, Applicant respectfully requests that this matter be set for hearing, that notice be given as required by law and that upon such hearing this Commission enter its order:

- A. Establishing an approximate 1,920-acre unconventional resource unit for the Application Lands, for production of oil, gas an associated hydrocarbons from the Codell and Niobrara Formations, and authorizing an appropriate number **OF WELLS THEREIN, AS DETERMINED BY BBC AND PERMITTED BY THE COMMISSION**, such wells to be drilled from surface locations within the proposed unit without exception granted by the Director.
- B. For any permitted wells to be drilled within the proposed unconventional resource unit, the treated intervals of the wellbore shall be no closer than 300 feet from unit boundaries, and no closer than 150 feet from the productive interval of any other wellbore located in the unit, without exception being granted by the Director.
- C. Providing that the **EXISTING WELLS** drilled and completed within the Application Lands will be included in the proposed unconventional resource unit **UPON**

ENTRY OF AN ORDER POOLING ALL INTERESTS IN THE UNCONVENTIONAL RESOURCE UNIT, OR UPON EXECUTION OF A VOLUNTARY AGREEMENT POOLING SUBSTANTIALLY ALL INTERESTS IN THE PROPOSED UNCONVENTIONAL RESOURCE UNIT.

- D. MAINTAINING THE DRILLING AND SPACING UNITS ESTABLISHED BY ORDER NOS. 407-779 AND 535-4, AND ORDER NO. 407-943 FOR THE EXISTING WELLS, BUT ONLY UNTIL SUCH TIME AS THE UNCONVENTIONAL RESOURCE UNIT IS POOLED BY VOLUNTARY AGREEMENT OR BY COMMISSION ORDER.
- E. MAINTAINING POOLING ORDER NOS. ORDER NOS. 407-811, 535-360, AND 407-915 FOR THE EXISTING WELLS, BUT ONLY UNTIL SUCH TIME AS THE UNCONVENTIONAL RESOURCE UNIT IS POOLED BY VOLUNTARY AGREEMENT OR BY COMMISSION ORDER.
 - F. Vacating Order No. 407-943 FOR THE CODELL FORMATION.
 - G. Vacating Order Nos. 407-822 and 535-382.
- H. Providing that relief granted under this **AMENDED APPLICATION** be effective on oral order by the Commission, relying on the Applicant's desire to be bound by said oral order.
- I. For such other findings and orders as the Commission may deem proper or advisable.


