NOTICE OF CONTINUTATION OF HEARING

TO ALL INTERESTED PARTIES AND TO WHOM IT MAY CONCERN:

On September 16, 2004, the Commission entered Order No. 1V-276, which among other things established a moratorium on drilling and completion operations within a two (2) mile radius of the seep at West Divide Creek until the Commission staff evaluates (1) the effectiveness of the Notice to All Operators Drilling Wells to the Mesaverde Group or Deeper in the Mamm Creek Field, Garfield County, effective July 23, 2004, and (2) EnCana's compliance with any applicable Site Investigation and Remediation Workplan, Form 27, as approved or amended by the COGCC staff related to the gas seep in the area of West Divide Creek. Although Order No. 1V-276 applied only to EnCana, the Commission subsequently entered Order No.191-8 which provided that Bill Barrett Corporation shall not drill on its operated lands within the moratorium area established under the Commission's Order No. 1V-276 so long as the order is in effect or until Bill Barrett Corporation has filed an application with the Commission and has been released from the order as it applies to the Bill Barrett Corporation operated lands within the moratorium area.

On January 26, 2006, Bill Barrett Corporation filed with the Commission a verified application for an order to allow limited drilling of the Williams Fork Formation wells within the Moratorium Area established in Order No. 1V-276 for the below-described lands. Applicant requests that these eighteen (18) wells be drilled anywhere upon the Application Lands located the Moratorium Area subject in each case to the well location setback limitations set forth in the Commission's Order No. 191-8 and further provided that no such well will be drilled within the Moratorium Area to a downhole location in the Williams Fork Formation closer than one (1) mile from the West Divide Creek seep in the SW¹/₄ NW¹/₄ of Section 12, Township 7 South, Range 92 West, 6th P.M.

On March 14, 2006, the Board of County Commissioners of Garfield County filed with the Commission a Motion to Amend and an Amended Motion by Garfield County Board of Commissioners.

On March 17, 2006, Bill Barrett Corporation continued the matter to the April 2006 hearing; accordingly, the hearing in this matter has been continued.
