On June 17, 1988, the Commission issued Order No. 112-60, which among other things, established 320-acre drilling and spacing units for certain lands in Townships 32 and 33 North, Ranges 9 through 11 West, N.M.P.M., for production of gas from the Fruitland coal seams, with the permitted well to be located no closer than nine hundred ninety (990) feet to any outer boundary, nor closer than one hundred thirty (130) feet to any interior quarter section line.

On April 20, 2007, BP America Production Company and the Southern Ute Indian Tribe, d/b/a Red Willow Production Company, by their attorney, filed with the Commission a verified application for an order to allow up to two (2) wells to be optionally drilled in the 320-acre drilling and spacing units for the below-listed lands, for the production of gas and associated hydrocarbons in the Fruitland coal seams, with the permitted well to be located no closer than nine hundred ninety (990) feet from the outer boundary of the unit nor closer than one hundred thirty (130) feet to any interior quarter section line,

An original and nine (9) copies shall be filed with the Commission (Rule 503.). Anyone who files a protest or intervention must be able to participate in a prehearing conference during the week of May 29, 2007. Pursuant to Rule 503.f., if a party who has received notice under Rule 503.b. wishes to receive further pleadings in the above-referenced matter, that party must file a protest or intervention in accordance with these rules. In accordance with the practices of the Commission, should no protests or interventions be filed in this matter by May 25, 2007, the Applicant may request that an administrative hearing be scheduled during the week of May 29, 2007. In the alternative, pursuant to Rule 511.b., if the matter is uncontested, the applicant may request, and the Director may recommend approval on the basis of the merits of the verified application and the supporting exhibits.
