## NOTICE OF CONTINUATION OF HEARING

On November 9, 1959, the Commission issued Order No. 112-6, which among other things, established 320-acre drilling and spacing units for certain lands including the  $E\frac{1}{2}$  of Section 17, Township 32 North, Range 6 West, N.M.P.M., for the production of gas and associated hydrocarbons from the Mesaverde Formation. Subsequently, on July 16, 1979, the Commission issued Order No. 112-46, which among other things allowed an optional second well to be drilled in the established 320-acre drilling and spacing unit for certain lands including the  $E\frac{1}{2}$  of Section 17, Township 32 North, Range 6 West, N.M.P.M., for the production of gas and associated hydrocarbons from the Mesaverde Formation.

On April 20, 2007, McElvain Oil and Gas Properties, Inc. ("McElvain"), by its attorney, filed with the Commission a verified application for an order to pool all nonconsenting interests in the 320-acre drilling and spacing unit consisting of the E½ of Section 17, Township 32 North, Range 6 West, N.N.P.M., for the development and operation of the Mesaverde Formation. McElvain plans to drill the Payne C #2 Well in the SW¼ SE¼ and Payne C #3 Well in the NW¼ NE¼ of Section 17, Township 32 North, Range 6 West, N.M.P.M. Offers to lease or to participate have been made to the mineral owners or the leasehold owners but as of the date the application was filed, not all of these attempts have been successful.

On May 23, 2007, Tracker Resource Development LLC, Snowflake Minerals, LLC, Peak Production Corp., Frikon Energy Corp and Wessco LLC, filed with the Commission a protest to the application and a motion to continue the application. The matter was continued to the July hearing, as the June hearing was cancelled.
