NOTICE OF HEARING

TO ALL INTERESTED PARTIES AND TO WHOM IT MAY CONCERN:

On April 20, 1990, the Commission issued Order No. 139-16, which among other things, established 640-acre drilling and spacing units for certain lands including Section 29, Township 6 South, Range 93 West, 6th P.M. for the production of gas and associated hydrocarbons from the Mesaverde Formation.

On June 6, 2005, the Commission issued Order No. 139-47, which among other things, established 640-acre drilling and spacing units for certain lands including Section 29, Township 6 South, Range 3 West, 6th P.M., and allowing the equivalent of on Williams Fork Formation well per ten acres, with the permitted well to be located no closer than 100 feet from the boundaries of the drilling and spacing units.

On March 14, 2008, Laramie Energy II, LLC., by its attorney, filed with the Commission a verified application for an order to allow the equivalent of one well per 10 acres to be drilled in the 640-acre drilling and spacing unit in Section 29, Township 6 South, Range 93 West, 6th P.M., for the production of gas and associated hydrocarbons from the Iles Formation.

All future Iles Formation wells to be drilled upon the application lands should be located downhole anywhere within the application lands but no closer than 100 feet from a lease line or the boundaries of the application lands without exception being granted by the Director of the Oil and Gas Conservation Commission. In cases where the application lands abut or corner lands in respect of which the Commission has not at the time of drilling permit application granted the right to drill 10-acre density Williams Fork and Iles Formation wells, the well should be located downhole no closer than 200 feet from the boundary or boundaries of the application lands so abutting or cornering such lands without exception being granted by the Director of the Oil and Gas Conservation Commission.

Except as previously authorized by order of the Commission, wells to be drilled under this application will be drilled from the surface either vertically or directionally from no more than one pad located on a given quarter quarter section (or lots or parcels approximately equivalent thereto) unless exception is granted by the Director of the Oil and Gas Conservation Commission pursuant to application made for such exception. In addition, all wells drilled to the Iles Formation will be drilled only in connection with the drilling of Williams Fork Formation wells.

The applicant agrees to comply with the terms and provisions of the Helmer Gulch Implementation Plan and the Well Cementing Procedure and Reporting Requirements in the Notice to Operators Drilling Mesaverde Group of Deeper Wells in the Mamm Creek Field Area dated July 23, 2004, which are incorporated by reference herein.

Pursuant to said hearing in the above-entitled matter at the time and place aforesaid, or at any adjourned meeting, the Commission will enter such orders as it deems appropriate to protect the health, safety and welfare of the public and to prevent the waste of oil and gas, either or both, in the operations of said field, and to carry out the purposes of the statute.

In accordance with Rule 509., any interested party desiring to protest the granting of the application or to intervene on the application should file with the Commission a written protest or intervention no later than April 24, 2008, briefly stating the basis of the protest or intervention. Such interested party shall, at the same time, serve a copy of the protest or intervention to the person filing the application. An original and 13 copies shall be filed with the Commission. Anyone who files a protest or intervention must be able to participate in a prehearing conference during the week of April 28, 2008. Pursuant to Rule 503.f., if a party who has received notice under Rule 503.b. wishes to receive further pleadings in the above-referenced matter, that party must file a protest or intervention in accordance with these rules. In accordance with the practices of the Commission, should no protests or interventions be filed in this matter by April 24, 2008, the Applicant may request that an administrative hearing be scheduled during the week of April 28, 2008. In the alternative, pursuant to Rule 511.b., if the matter is uncontested, the applicant may request, and the Director may recommend approval on the basis of the merits of the verified application and the supporting exhibits.
