## NOTICE OF CANCELLATION OF HEARING

## TO ALL INTERESTED PARTIES AND TO WHOM IT MAY CONCERN:

Rule 318.a. of the Rules and Regulations of the Commission requires that wells drilled in excess of 2,500 feet in depth be located not less than 600 feet from any lease line, and located not less than 1,200 feet from any other producible or drilling oil or gas well when drilling to the same common source of supply. Section 19, Township 2 South, Range 46 West, 6<sup>th</sup> P.M., is subject to this Rule.

Rule 318B. of the Rules and Regulations of the Commission (the Special Well Location Rule ("WLR")) governs wells drilled to, and completed in, the Niobrara Formation for certain lands, including Section 19, Township 2 South, Range 46 West, 6th P.M., which allows operators to drill up to four (4) wells in any quarter section, with no more than one (1) well located in any quarter quarter section and no minimum distance required between wells in any quarter section with wells located no closer than 300 feet from the outer boundary of said quarter section. Further, wells hall be located no less than 900 feet from any producible well drilled to the Niobrara Formation prior to this WLR's effective date (July 30, 2006) located in a contiguous or cornering quarter section unless exception is approved by the Director.

On February 19, 2009, T.H. McElvain Oil & Gas L.P., by its attorney, filed with the Commission a verified amended application for an order to establish three 160-acre drilling and spacing units consisting of the NW¼, NE¼ and SE¼ of Section 19, Township 2 South, Range 46 West, 6<sup>th</sup> P.M., and pool all nonconsenting interests in said units for the development and operation of the Niobrara Formation.

On March 11, 2009, T.H. McElvain Oil & Gas L.P., by its attorney, filed with the Commission a written request to withdraw the application; accordingly, the hearing in this matter has been cancelled.
