### NOTICE OF HEARING

#### TO ALL INTERESTED PARTIES AND TO WHOM IT MAY CONCERN:

On April 27, 1998, the Commission adopted Rule 318A., which, among other things, allowed certain drilling locations to be utilized to drill or twin a well, deepen a well or recomplete a well and to commingle any or all of the Cretaceous Age Formations from the base of the Dakota Formation to the surface. Pursuant to Rule 318A.a.(2) and (4), when drilling a well to any Cretaceous Age formation, operators may utilize a surface location that is a square with sides eight hundred (800) feet in length, the center of which is the center of any governmental quarter section, whether in spaced or unspaced formations, and the operator shall form a voluntary drilling and spacing unit consisting of the governmental quarter section. Section 31, Township 7 North, Range 63 West, 6<sup>th</sup> P.M. is subject to this Rule for the Codell and Niobrara Formations.

On October 6, 2010, Great Western Oil and Gas Company, by its attorney, filed with the Commission a verified application to pool all nonconsenting interests for a designated 160-acre drilling and spacing unit for the below-listed lands, to accommodate the **Heinze #31-53 Well** (API #05-123-29743), located in the SW¼ SW¼ of Section 31, Township 7 North, Range 63 West, 6<sup>th</sup> P.M., for the development and operation of the Codell and Niobrara Formations:

In accordance with Rule 509., any interested party desiring to protest the granting of the application or to intervene on the application should file with the Commission a written protest or intervention no later than November 12, 2010, briefly stating the basis of the protest or intervention. Such interested party shall, at the same time, serve a copy of the protest or intervention to the person filing the application. An original and 13 copies shall be filed with the Commission. Anyone who files a protest or intervention must be able to participate in a prehearing conference during the week of November 15, 2010. Pursuant to Rule 503.f., if a party who has received notice under Rule 503.b. wishes to receive further pleadings in the above-referenced matter, that party must file a protest or intervention in accordance with these rules. In accordance with the practices of the Commission, should no protests or interventions be filed in this matter by November 12, 2010, the Applicant may request that an administrative hearing be scheduled during the week of November 15, 2010. In the alternative, pursuant to Rule 511.b., if the matter is uncontested, the applicant may request,

and the Director may recommend approval on the basis of the merits of the verified application and the supporting exhibits.
