NOTICE OF ORDER FINDING VIOLATION HEARING

Pursuant to Rule 522.c., the Colorado Oil and Gas Conservation Commission ("Commission" or "COGCC") Staff will apply to the Commission on April 4, 2011 for a Order Finding Violation ("OFV") against Aspen Operating, LLC ("Aspen").

The request for OFV involves Aspen's operation of certain wells in Delta County, namely:

- Hamilton #32-1 Well (API No. 05-029-06097), located in the NE¼ SE¼ of Section 32, Township 13 South, Range 95 West, 6th P.M.,
- Hamilton #32-4 Well (API No. 05-029-06101), located in the SE¼ SW¼ of said Section 32,
- Hamilton #33-2 Well (API No. 05-029-06100), located in the NE¼ SW¼ of Section 33, Township 13 South, Range 95 West, 6th P.M., and
- Hamilton #33-3 Well (API No. 05-029-06102), located in the NW¼ NW¼ of said Section 33, known collectively as the "Hamilton wells".

The COGCC Staff asserts that the Hamilton wells were drilled and completed in 2006, and have been temporarily abandoned without Director approval since that time. Further, Aspen has not performed a successful mechanical integrity test on the wells since their completion, and has not filed complete required reports on the wells (to include a Drilling Completion Report, Form 5, and Completed Interval Report, Form 5A). Further, Aspen has not posted the required financial assurance for the wells.

COGCC Staff contends Aspen violated Rules 206., 308A., 319.b.(1), 319.b.(3), 326.b.(1), and 706., at each of the Hamilton wells.

In accordance with Rule 509., any interested party desiring to protest the granting of the application or to intervene on the application should file with the Commission a written protest or intervention no later than March 21, 2011, briefly stating the basis of the protest or intervention. Such interested party shall, at the same time, serve a copy of the protest or intervention to the person filing the application. An original and 13 copies shall be filed with the Commission. Anyone who files a protest or intervention must be able to participate in a prehearing conference during the week of March 21, 2011.
