On December 19, 2007, COGCC Staff issued NOAV #200123651 to White for its operations at the Hair-Snodgrass #1 Well. Said NOAV cited violations for various rules, including Rules 308A. and 319.a.(3).

The NOAV required White to file appropriate drilling and plugging reports by February 29, 2008.

The COGCC staff requests White be found in violation of Rules 308A. and 319.a.(3). for its operation of Hair-Snodgrass #1 Well.

Hair #1 Well

On April 18, 2002, White spud the Hair-Snodgrass #1 Well (API No. 05-017-07620), which is located in the SW 1 NE 1 4 of Section 14, Township 15 South, Range 45 West, 6^{th} P.M.

On December 19, 2007, COGCC Staff issued NOAV #200123649 to White for its operations at the Hair #1 Well. Said NOAV cited violations for various rules, including Rules 308A. and 319.a.(3).

The NOAV required White to file appropriate drilling and plugging reports by February 29, 2008.

The COGCC staff requests White be found in violation of Rules 308A. and 319.a.(3). for its operation of Hair-Snodgrass #1 Well.

Anyone who files a protest or intervention must be able to participate in a prehearing conference during the week of July 25, 2011.
