**AMENDED NOTICE OF HEARING**

TO ALL INTERESTED PARTIES AND TO WHOM IT MAY CONCERN:

**This Amended Notice of Hearing sets forth a new deadline for any interested party to protest the granting of the application or intervene on the application. The new deadline to protest/intervene is February 16, 2011. Anyone who files a protest or intervention must be able to participate in a prehearing conference on either February 17 or 18, 2011. No other changes have been made to the content in the prior Notice of Hearing issued on January 18, 2011.**

On December 2, 1999, the Commission issued Order No. 520-1, which among other things, established 160-acre drilling and spacing units for certain lands including the SW¼ of Section 4, Township 29 South, Range 69 West, 6<sup>th</sup> P.M., for production of oil, gas (including CO<sub>2</sub>) and associated hydrocarbons from the Dakota and Entrada Formations.

On **November 24, 2010**, Spoon Valley Energy, LLC ("Spoon Valley"), by its attorneys, filed with the Commission a verified application for an order to pool all nonconsenting interests in the established approximate 160-acre drilling and spacing unit for the below-described lands (to accommodate the Cougar #1A Well (the "Well"), API #05-055-06301), for the development and operation of the Dakota and Entrada Formations, effective as of the reentry date of the Well:

Township 29 South, Range 69 West, 6<sup>th</sup> P.M.  
Section 4: SW¼

**In accordance with Rule 509., any interested party desiring to protest the granting of the application or to intervene on the application should file with the Commission a written protest or intervention no later than February 16, 2011, briefly stating the basis of the protest or intervention. Such interested party shall, at the same time, serve a copy of the protest or intervention to the person filing the application. An original and 13 copies shall be filed with the Commission. Anyone who files a protest or intervention must be able to participate in a prehearing conference on either February 17 or 18, 2011.**
