AMENDED NOTICE OF HEARING

TO ALL INTERESTED PARTIES AND TO WHOM IT MAY CONCERN:

This Amended Notice of Hearing sets forth a new deadline for any interested party to protest the granting of the application or intervene on the application. The new deadline to protest/intervene is February 16, 2011. Anyone who files a protest or intervention must be able to participate in a prehearing conference on either February 17 or 18, 2011. No other changes have been made to the content in the prior Notice of Hearing issued on January 18, 2011.

On December 19, 1983, the Commission issued Order No. 407-1 (amended on March 29, 2000 in accordance with Order No. 407-17, entered November 18, 1985), which among other things, established 80-acre drilling and spacing units for the production of oil and/or gas and associated hydrocarbons from the Codell Formation underlying certain lands, including Section 12, Township 3 North, Range 68 West, 6th P.M., with the drilling and spacing unit to be designated by the operator drilling the first well in the quarter section, (or the Director, if the operator fails to designate). The permitted well shall be located in the center of either 40-acre tract within the drilling and spacing unit with a tolerance of 200 feet in any direction. The operator shall have the option to drill an additional well on the undrilled 40-acre tract in each 80-acre drilling and spacing unit.

On February 19, 1992, the Commission issued Order No. 407-87 (amended August 20, 1993), which among other things, established 80-acre drilling and spacing units for the production of oil and/or gas from the Codell and Niobrara Formations underlying certain lands, including Section 12, Township 3 North, Range 68 West, 6th P.M., with the permitted well locations in accordance with the provisions of Order No. 407-1.

On April 27, 1998, the Commission adopted Rule 318A., which, among other things, allowed certain drilling locations to be utilized to drill or twin a well, deepen a well or recomplete a well and to commingle any or all of the Cretaceous Age Formations from the base of the Dakota Formation to the surface. Section 12, Township 3 North, Range 68 West, 6th P.M. is subject to this Rule for the Codell and Niobrara Formations.

On December 8, 2010, Apollo Operating, LLC ("Apollo"), by its attorney, filed with the Commission a verified application for an order to: (1) pool all nonconsenting interests within an approximate 80-acre designated drilling and spacing unit for the below-described lands (to accommodate the Martin #33-12 Well (API #05-123-31982), with a planned bottomhole location of 1,992 feet FSL and 2,001 feet FEL of Section 12, Township 3 North, Range 68 West, 6th P.M., and the Martin #34-12D Well (API #05-123-32309), with a planned bottomhole location of 664 feet FSL and 2,004 feet FEL of said Section 12), for the development and operation of the Codell and Niobrara Formations:

Township 3 North, Range 68 West, 6th P.M. Section 12: W½ SE¼

and, (2) pool all nonconsenting interests within an approximate 80-acre designated drilling and spacing unit for the below-described lands (to accommodate the Martin #43-12 Well (API #05-123-31981), with a planned bottomhole location of 1,798 feet FSL and 755 feet FEL of said Section 12, and the Martin #44-12D Well (API #05-123-32310), with a planned bottomhole location of 663 feet FSL and 668 feet FEL of said Section 12), for the development and operation of the Codell and Niobrara Formations:

Township 3 North, Range 68 West, 6th P.M. Section 12: E½ SE¼

Further, Apollo requests that this pooling order be retroactive to the spud date of

each well.

Such interested party shall, at the same time, serve a copy of the protest or intervention to the person filing the application. An original and 13 copies shall be filed with the Commission. Anyone who files a protest or intervention must be able to participate in a prehearing conference on either February 17 or 18, 2011.
