NOTICE OF HEARING

TO ALL INTERESTED PARTIES AND TO WHOM IT MAY CONCERN:

Rule 318.a. of the Rules and Regulations of the Oil and Gas Conservation Commission requires that wells drilled in excess of 2,500 feet in depth be located not less than 600 feet from any lease line, and located not less than 1,200 feet from any other producible or drilling oil or gas well when drilling to the same common source of supply. The below-listed lands are subject to this Rule for the Niobrara Formation:

On February 22, 2011, the Commission issued Order No. 535-3, which among other things, established approximate 640-acre drilling and spacing units for certain lands, including Section 24, Township 8 North, Range 62 West, 6th P.M., and approved of one horizontal well in each unit, for the production of oil, gas and associated hydrocarbons from the Niobrara Formation.

On April 27, 2011, Continental Resources, Inc. ("Continental" or "Applicant"), by its attorneys, filed with the Commission a verified application (the "Application") for an order to: (1) vacate the approximate 640-acre drilling and spacing unit established for Section 24, Township 8 North, Range 62 West, 6th P.M.; (2) establish six approximate 1,280-acre drilling and spacing units for the below-listed lands, and approve one horizontal well within each unit, for the production of oil, gas and associated hydrocarbons from the Niobrara Formation, with the treated interval of the wellbore for any permitted well to be no closer than 600 feet from the unit boundaries without exception being granted by the Director; and (3) establish eight approximate 640-acre drilling and spacing units for the below-listed lands, and approve one horizontal well within each unit, for the production of oil, gas and associated hydrocarbons from the Niobrara Formation, with the treated interval of the wellbore in each case to be no closer than 600 feet from the proposed drilling and spacing unit boundaries without exception being granted by the Director:

In accordance with Rule 509., any interested party desiring to protest the granting of the Application or to intervene on the Application should file with the Commission a written protest or intervention no later than June 13, 2011, briefly stating the basis of the protest or intervention. Such interested party shall, at the same time, serve a copy of the protest or intervention to the person filing the Application. An original and 13 copies shall be filed with the Commission. Anyone who files a protest or intervention must be able to participate in a prehearing conference during the week of June 13, 2011. Pursuant to Rule 503.g., if a party who has received notice under Rule 503.b. wishes to receive further pleadings in the above-referenced matter, that party must file a protest or intervention in accordance with these rules. In accordance with the practices of the Commission, should no protests or interventions be filed in this matter by June 13, 2011, the Applicant may request that an administrative hearing be scheduled during the week of June 13, 2011. In the alternative, pursuant to Rule 511., if the matter is uncontested, the applicant may request, and the Director may recommend approval on the basis of the merits of the verified Application and the supporting exhibits.
