NOTICE OF HEARING

TO ALL INTERESTED PARTIES AND TO WHOM IT MAY CONCERN:

On April 4, 2011, the Commission, acting pursuant to an application filed by Antero Resources Piceance Corporation ("Antero" or "Applicant") on October 8, 2010, will consider establishing an approximate 625-acre drilling and spacing unit, and authorizing the drilling of up to 16 wells within the unit, for certain lands located in Section 33, Township 5 South, Range 91 West, 6th P.M., Section 6, Township 6 South, Range 91 West, 6th P.M., and Section 1, Township 6 South, Range 92 West, 6th P.M., for the production of gas and associated hydrocarbons from the Williams Fork and Iles Formations.

On March 16, 2011, Antero, by its attorney, filed with the Commission a verified application for an order to pool all nonconsenting interests in the approximate 625-acre drilling and spacing unit which may be established for the below-described lands, for the development and operation of the Williams Fork and Iles Formations, effective as of the commencement date of operations for the Maves #A1 Well (API #05-045-19732):

Section 33: SE $\frac{1}{4}$, E $\frac{1}{2}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, and E $\frac{1}{2}$ W $\frac{1}{2}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$

Section 6: NW $\frac{1}{4}$

Township 6 South, Range 92 West, 6th P.M.
Section 1: NE $\frac{1}{4}$

Pursuant to said hearing in the above-entitled matter at the time and place aforesaid, or at any adjourned meeting, the Commission will enter such orders as it deems appropriate to protect the health, safety and welfare of the public and to prevent the waste of oil and gas, either or both, in the operations of said field, and to carry out the purposes of the statute.

In accordance with Rule 509., any interested party desiring to protest the granting of the application or to intervene on the application should file with the Commission a written protest or intervention no later than May 2, 2011, briefly stating the basis of the protest or intervention. Such interested party shall, at the same time, serve a copy of the protest or intervention to the person filing the application. An original and 13 copies shall be filed with the Commission. **Anyone who files a protest or intervention must be able to participate in a prehearing conference during the week of May 2, 2011.** Pursuant to Rule 503.g., if a party who has received notice under Rule 503.b. wishes to receive further pleadings in the above-referenced matter, that party must file a protest or intervention in accordance with these rules. In accordance

with the practices of the Commission, should no protests or interventions be filed in this matter by **May 2, 2011, the Applicant may request that an administrative hearing be scheduled during the week of May 2, 2011.** In the alternative, pursuant to Rule 511., if the matter is uncontested, the applicant may request, and the Director may recommend approval on the basis of the merits of the verified application and the supporting exhibits.
