NOTICE OF HEARING

TO ALL INTERESTED PARTIES AND TO WHOM IT MAY CONCERN:

Rule 318.a. of the Rules and Regulations of the Oil and Gas Conservation Commission requires that wells drilled in excess of 2,500 feet in depth be located not less than 600 feet from any lease line, and located not less than 1,200 feet from any other producible or drilling oil or gas well when drilling to the same common source of supply, unless authorized by order of the Commission upon hearing. Sections 29, 34, and 35, Township 4 South, Range 64 West, 6th P.M.; Sections 1, 3, 4, 5, 14, 23, 24, 25 and 36, Township 5 South, Range 64 West, 6th P.M.; and Sections 18, 19 and 30, Township 5 South, Range 63 West, 6th P.M. are subject to Rule 318a., for the production of oil, gas and associated hydrocarbons from the Niobrara Formation.

On January 5, 2012, ConocoPhillips Company ("ConocoPhillips" or "Applicant"), by its attorney, filed with the Commission a verified application, ("Application") (amended on February 3, 2012 by the withdrawal of two sections, Section 36, Township 4 South, Range 64 West, 6th P.M., and Section 2, Township 5 South, Range 64 West, 6th P.M.) for an order to establish 15 approximate 640-acre drilling and spacing units for the below-described lands ("Application Lands"), and authorize a horizontal well with the option to drill a second horizontal well in each proposed unit, for the production of oil, gas and associated hydrocarbons from the Niobrara Formation, with the treated interval of the permitted wellbore(s) to be located no closer than 460 feet from the boundaries of the proposed units, and no closer than 920 feet from the completed interval of another well producing from the same common source of supply, without exception being granted by the Director:

Township 4 South, Range 64 West, 6th P.M. Sections 29, 34, and 35: All

Township 5 South, Range 64 West, 6th P.M. Sections 1, 3, 4, 5, 14, 23, 24, 25 and 36: All

Township 5 South, Range 63 West, 6th P.M. Sections 18, 19, and 30:

Further, Applicant requested that the proposed well location rules apply to horizontal wells only, with vertical and directional wells in the Niobrara Formation remaining subject to Rule 318.a.

Pursuant to said hearing in the above-entitled matter at the time and place aforesaid, or at any adjourned meeting, the Commission will enter such orders as it deems appropriate to protect the health, safety and welfare of the public and to prevent the waste of oil and gas, either or both, in the operations of said field, and to carry out the purposes of the statute.

In accordance with Rule 509., any interested party desiring to protest the granting of the application or to intervene on the application should file with the Commission a written protest or intervention no later than February 17, 2012, briefly stating the basis of the protest or intervention. Such interested party shall, at the same time, serve a copy of the protest or intervention to the person filing the application. An original and 13 copies shall be filed with the Commission. Anyone who files a protest or intervention must be able to participate in a prehearing conference during the week of February 17, 2012. Pursuant to Rule 503.g., if a party who has received notice under Rule 503.b. wishes to receive further pleadings in the above-referenced matter, that party must file a protest or intervention in accordance with these rules. In accordance with the practices of the Commission, should no protests or interventions be filed in this matter by February 17, 2012, the Applicant may request that an administrative hearing be scheduled beginning February 17, 2012. In the alternative, pursuant to Rule 511., if the matter is uncontested, the applicant may request, and the Director may recommend approval on the basis of the merits of the verified application and the supporting exhibits.
