NOTICE OF HEARING

TO ALL INTERESTED PARTIES AND TO WHOM IT MAY CONCERN:

On April 27, 1988, the Commission adopted Rule 318A, which among other things, allowed certain drilling locations to be utilized to drill or twin a well, deepen a well or recomplete a well and to commingle any or all Cretaceous Age Formations from the base of the Dakota Formation to the surface. Rule 318A supersedes all prior Commission drilling and spacing orders affecting well location and density requirements of Greater Wattenberg Area wells. On December 5, 2005, Rule 318A was amended, among other things, to allow interior infill and boundary wells to be drilled and wellbore spacing units to be established. On August 8, 2011, Rule 318A was again amended, among other things, to address drilling of horizontal wells. Section 18, Township 5 North, Range 61 West, 6th P.M. and Section 15, Township 5 North, Range 62 West, 6th P.M. are subject to this Order for the Niobrara Formation.

On November 29, 2010, the Commission entered Order No. 407-380 which, among other things, established fifteen approximate 640-acre drilling and spacing units, and authorized one horizontal well within each unit, for the production of oil, gas and associated hydrocarbons from the Niobrara Formation. Section 18, Township 5 North, Range 61 West, 6th P.M. and Section 15, Township 5 North, Range 62 West, 6th P. M. are subject to this Order for the Niobrara Formation.

On May 29, 2012, the Commission entered Order No. 407-633 which, among other things, approved the drilling of one or more additional wells within each unit. Section 18, Township 5 North, Range 61 West, 6th P.M. and Section 15, Township 5 North, Range 62 West, 6th P. M. are subject to this Order for the Niobrara Formation.

On June 27, 2012, Bonanza Creek Energy Operating Company LLC ("Bonanza" or "Applicant"), by its attorneys, filed with the Commission pursuant to § 34-60-116 C.R.S., a verified application ("Application") for an order to affirm Order Nos. 407-380 and 407-633 to apply to interested parties which were not provided notice of the initial hearing in these matters, for the below-described lands ("Application Lands"):

Pursuant to said hearing in the above-entitled matter at the time and place aforesaid, or at any adjourned meeting, the Commission will enter such orders as it deems appropriate to protect the health, safety and welfare of the public and to prevent the waste of oil and gas, either or both, in the operations of said field, and to carry out the purposes of the statute.

In accordance with Rule 509., any interested party desiring to protest the granting of the application or to intervene on the application should file with the Commission a written protest or intervention no later than September 17, 2012, briefly stating the basis of the protest or intervention. Such interested party shall, at the same time, serve a copy of the protest or intervention to the person filing the application. An original and 13 copies shall be filed with the Commission. Anyone who files a protest or intervention must be able to participate in a prehearing conference during the week of September 17, 2012. Pursuant to Rule 503.g., if a party who has received notice under Rule 503.b. wishes to receive further pleadings in the above-referenced matter, that party must file a protest or intervention in accordance with these rules. In accordance with the practices of the Commission, should no protests or interventions be filed in this matter by September 17, 2012, the Applicant may request that an administrative hearing be scheduled beginning September 17, 2012. In the alternative, pursuant to Rule 511., if the matter is uncontested, the applicant may request, and the Director may recommend approval on the basis of the merits of the verified application and the supporting exhibits.
