NOTICE OF ORDER FINDING VIOLATION HEARING

TO ALL INTERESTED PARTIES AND TO WHOM IT MAY CONCERN:

Pursuant to Rule 522.c., the Colorado Oil and Gas Conservation Commission ("Commission" or "COGCC") Staff will apply to the Commission on July 29, 2013 for an Order Finding Violation ("OFV") against A.G. Andrikopoulos Resources ("Andrikopoulos").

Andrikopoulos (Operator No. 3085) operates the following wells: a) James Et Al #1 (API No. 05-081-06400), located in SE¼, NE¼, of Section 7, Township 4 North, Range 98 West, 6th P.M., spud on April 30, 1989; and b) Elk Springs Unit # 14-32 (API No. 05-081-06759), located in SW¼, SW¼, of Section 32, Township 5 North, Range 98 West, 6th P.M., spud on April 2, 2001.

On January 10, 2013 COGCC Staff issued Notice of Alleged Violations ("NOAV's") #200372813 and #200372814 to Andrikopoulos for alleged violations of Rule 319.b and Rule 326.b.(1)

Rule 523 specifies a base fine of One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000) for each day of violation of Rules 319.b. and 326.b.(1). Rule 523.a.(3) specifies that the maximum penalty for any single violation shall not exceed \$10,000 regardless of the number of days of such violation, unless the violation results in significant waste of oil and gas resources, damage to correlative rights, or a significant adverse impact on public health, safety or welfare or the environment. Staff has calculated a base fine of \$40,000 for the alleged rule violations based on no significant impact, and 10 day duration for each violation.

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN, pursuant to: 1) the general jurisdiction granted to the Oil and Gas Conservation Commission of the State of Colorado (Commission) under § 34-60-105 C.R.S.; 2) specific powers granted pursuant to § 34-60-106 C.R.S.; 3) the Colorado Administrative Procedures Act at § 24-4-105 C.R.S.; and 4) the Commission's Series 500 Rules at 2CCR 404-1, that the Commission has scheduled the above-entitled matter for hearing on:

Pursuant to said hearing in the above-entitled matter at the time and place aforesaid, or at any adjourned meeting, the Commission will enter such orders as it deems appropriate to protect the health, safety and welfare of the public and to prevent the waste of oil and gas, either or both, in the operations of said field, and to carry out the purposes of the statute.

In accordance with Rule 509., any interested party desiring to protest the granting of the application or to intervene on the application should file with the Commission a written protest or intervention no later than July 15, 2013 briefly stating the basis of the protest or intervention. An original and two copies shall be filed with the Commission along with an electronic version. Anyone who files a protest or intervention must be able to participate in a prehearing conference during the week of July 15, 2013. Pursuant to Rule 503.g., if a party who has received notice under Rule 503.b. wishes to receive further pleadings in the above-referenced matter, that party must file a protest or intervention in accordance with these rules.
