NOTICE OF HEARING

TO ALL INTERESTED PARTIES AND TO WHOM IT MAY CONCERN:

On February 27, 2014 (Amended March 31, 2014), WPX Energy Rocky Mountain, LLC ("WPX" or "Applicant"), by its attorneys, filed with the Commission pursuant to §34-60-116 C.R.S., a verified application ("Amended Application") for an order to:

- 1) Establish an approximate 1132-acre exploratory drilling unit for the Mancos, Niobrara, Frontier, Mowry, and Dakota Formations.
- 2) Approve the one or more horizontal wells, and one or more vertical or directional wells within the unit.
- 3) Require the productive interval of the wellbore to be located no closer than 600 feet from the eastern and western unit boundaries and not less than 300 feet from the northern and southern unit boundaries, and no closer than 300 feet from the treated interval of any other wellbore located in the unit.
- 4) Applicant requests to locate the surface facilities for the proposed wells be drilled from the new, common or existing wellpads from the surface either on the Application Lands or on adjacent lands with consent of the landowner, from no more than one wellpad located on a given quarter quarter section (or lots or parcels approximately equivalent thereto), unless exception is granted by the Director.
