On April 16, 2012, the Commission entered Order No. 407-621 which pooled all interests in an approximate 160-acre designated wellbore spacing unit for the Codell and Niobrara Formations, including the S½ SE¼ of Section 2, Township 6 North, Range 66 West, 6th P.M. and approved cost recovery pursuant to §34-60-116(7) for the Leffler 2TD Well (API No. 05-123-31969).

On November 15, 2012, the Commission entered Order No. 407-729 which pooled all interests in an approximate 160-acre designated wellbore spacing unit for the Codell and Niobrara Formations, including the E½ SE¼ of Section 2, Township 6 North, Range 66 West, 6th P.M. and approved cost recovery pursuant to §34-60-116(7) for the Leffler 2XD Well (API No. 05-123-31970).

On March 25, 2013, the Commission entered Order No. 407-772 which pooled all

interests in an approximate 160-acre designated wellbore spacing unit for the Codell and Niobrara Formations, including the $5\frac{1}{2}$ NE¼ and the N½ SE¼ of Section 2, Township 6 North, Range 66 West, 6^{th} P.M. and approved cost recovery pursuant to §34-60-116(7) for the Leffler 2SD Well (API No. 05-123-32326).
