APPLICATION

On April 17, 2014, Red Hawk Petroleum, LLC ("Red Hawk" or "Applicant") filed a verified application pursuant to §34-60-116 C.R.S. for an order to:

- 1) Approve up to eight horizontal wells within an approximate 640-acre drilling and spacing unit established by Order Nos. 407-514 and 535-104 for the Niobrara Formation; and
- 2) Require the productive interval of the wellbore to be located no closer than 600 feet from the unit boundaries, and no closer than 150 feet from the productive interval of any other wellbore located in the unit.

On December 12, 2011, the Commission entered Order Nos. 407-514 and 535-104 which established an approximate 640-acre drilling and spacing unit for Section 1, Township 7 North, Range 60 West, 6th P.M. and approved one horizontal well within the unit, for the production of oil, gas and associated hydrocarbons from the Niobrara Formation.

On January 23, 2012, the Commission entered Order No. 535-140 which pooled all interests in an approximate 640-acre drilling and spacing unit established for Section 1, Township 7 North, Range 60 West, 6th P.M., for the development and operation of the Niobrara Formation.

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN, pursuant to: 1) the general jurisdiction granted to the Oil and Gas Conservation Commission of the State of Colorado under §34-60-105 C.R.S.; 2) specific powers granted pursuant to §34-60-106 C.R.S.; 3) the State Administrative Procedures Act at §24-4-105 C.R.S.; and 4) the Commission's Series 500 Rules at 2 CCR 404-1, that the Commission has scheduled the above-entitled matter for hearing on:

One electronic (cogcc.hearings_unit@state.co.us), one original and two copies shall be filed with the Commission. **Anyone who files a protest or intervention must be able to participate in a prehearing conference during the week of June 2, 2014.** Pursuant to Rule 511., if the matter is uncontested, it may be approved without a hearing, based on review of the merits of the verified application and supporting exhibits.
