On April 17, 2014, Red Hawk Petroleum, LLC ("Red Hawk" or "Applicant") filed a verified application pursuant to §34-60-116 C.R.S. for an order to:

- 1) Approve up to 14 horizontal wells within an approximate 1280-acre drilling and spacing unit established by Orders Nos. 407-514 and 535-104 for the Niobrara Formation; and
- 2) Require the productive interval of the wellbore to be located no closer than 600 feet from the unit boundaries, and no closer than 150 feet from the productive interval of any other wellbore located in the unit.

On December 12, 2011, the Commission entered Order Nos. 407-514 and 535-104 which established an approximate 1280-acre drilling and spacing unit for Sections 2 and 11, Township 7 North, Range 60 West, 6th P.M. and approved one horizontal well within the unit, for the production of oil, gas and associated hydrocarbons from the Niobrara Formation.

On January 23, 2012, the Commission entered Order No. 535-137 which pooled all interests within the approximate 1,280-acre drilling and spacing unit, for the development and operation of the Niobrara Formation.

On November 15, 2012, the Commission entered Order Nos. 407-725 and 535-214 which approved up to two horizontal wells within the approximate 1,280-acre drilling and spacing unit.
