APPLICATION

On April 17, 2014 (Amended May 27, 2014), Southwestern Energy Production Company ("Southwestern" or "Applicant") filed a verified application pursuant to §34-60-116 C.R.S. for an order to:

- 1) Establish an approximate 800-acre drilling and spacing unit for the Mancos and Niobrara Formations;
- 2) Determine the appropriate number of wells to efficiently and economically recover the oil, gas and associated hydrocarbons from the Mancos and Niobrara Formations; and
- 3) Require the productive interval of the wellbore to be located no closer than 600 feet from the unit boundaries, and no closer than **150** feet from the productive interval of any other wellbore located in the unit.

Rule 318.a. requires that, for unspaced lands, wells drilled in excess of 2,500 feet in depth be located not less than 600 feet from any lease line, and located not less than 1,200 feet from any other producible or drilling oil or gas well when drilling to the same common source of supply.
