- 1) Pool all interests in an approximate 320-acre drilling and spacing unit for the Application Lands, effective as of the earlier of the date of the Application, for the development and operation of the Williams Fork Formation; and
- 2) Subject any nonconsenting interests to the cost recovery provisions of C.R.S. §34-60-116(7), for the drilling of the initial Williams Fork Formation well and any other wells authorized by Order No. 440-61.

- On May 18, 1990, Order No. 440-12 established, among other things, an approximate 320-acre drilling and spacing unit for the Application Lands, and approved the option to drill a total of up to two wells in each operator-designated unit, for the production of gas and associated hydrocarbons from the Mesaverde Formation, including the Williams Fork Formation.
- On June 1, 2010, Order No. 440-61 approved the equivalent of one well per 10 acres well density for the Application Lands, for the production of gas and associated hydrocarbons from the Williams Fork Formation.
