NOTICE OF HEARING

TO ALL INTERESTED PARTIES AND TO WHOM IT MAY CONCERN:

On December 19, 2014, Great Western Operating Company, LLC (Operator No. 10110) ("Applicant"), by its attorneys, filed a verified application ("Application") with the Commission pursuant to §34-60-116 C.R.S., for an order to:

- 1) Establish an approximate 1,175-acre drilling and spacing unit, for the production of oil, gas and associated hydrocarbons from the Codell-Niobrara Formation.
- 2) Approve up to 28 horizontal wells within the unit, for the production of oil, gas and associated hydrocarbons from the Codell-Niobrara Formation.
- 3) Require the productive interval of the horizontal wellbore to be located no closer than 460 feet from any unit boundary and no closer than 150 feet to the treated interval of any other horizontal wellbore in the unit permitted to the same formation, without exception being granted by the Director.

PRIOR RULES AND ORDERS

- On April 27, 1998, the Commission adopted Rule 318A, the Greater Wattenberg Area Special Well Location, Spacing and Unit Designation Rule.
- On February 19, 1992 (amended August 20, 1993), Order No. 407-87 established 80-acre drilling and spacing units for the production of oil, gas and associated hydrocarbons from the Codell and Niobrara Formations, with the permitted well locations in accordance with the provisions of Order No. 407-1.
- On January 7, 2013 (corrected June 27, 2013), Order No. 407-742 vacated drilling and spacing units and established two approximate 320-acre and 480-acre drilling and

spacing units, for the production of oil, gas and associated hydrocarbons from the Codell-Niobrara Formation.

- On July 29, 2013, Order No. 407-835 pooled all interests in an approximate 160-acre designated wellbore spacing unit established for Section 20, Township 6 North, Range 67 West, 6th P.M., to accommodate the H-Y 20-54 Well, for the development and operation of the Codell-Niobrara Formation.
- On September 16, 2013, Order No. 407-851 approved up to 12 horizontal wells within a drilling and spacing unit, for the production of oil, gas and associated hydrocarbons from the Codell-Niobrara Formation.
- On September 15, 2014, Order No. 407-1104 vacated an approximate 320-acre drilling and spacing unit ("DSU #1") established by Order No. 407-472 for Section 30, Township 6 North, Range 67 West, 6th P.M., modify Order No. 407-742 to reflect a corrected acreage of 450 acres for the drilling and spacing unit ("DSU #2") established for Sections 19 and 30, Township 6 North, Range 67 West, 6th P.M., vacate Order No. 407-851 in its entirety, and modify DSU #2 to allow only one horizontal well, the Raindance FD 19-21HN Well, within the approximate 450-acre drilling and spacing unit, for the production of oil, gas, and associated hydrocarbons from the Codell-Niobrara Formation.

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN, pursuant to: 1) the general jurisdiction granted to the Oil and Gas Conservation Commission of the State of Colorado under §34-60-105 C.R.S.; 2) specific powers granted pursuant to §34-60-106 C.R.S.; 3) the State Administrative Procedures Act at §24-4-105 C.R.S.; and 4) the Commission's Series 500 Rules at 2 CCR 404-1, that the Commission has scheduled the above-entitled matter for hearing on:

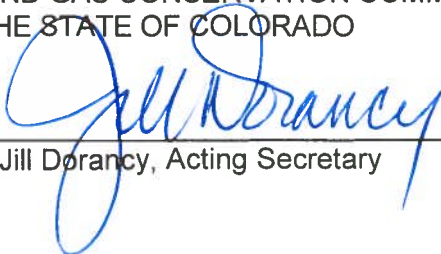

One electronic (cogcc.hearings_unit@state.co.us), one original and two copies shall be filed with the Commission. **Anyone who files a protest or intervention must be able to participate in a prehearing conference during the week of January 12, 2015.** Pursuant to Rule 511., if the matter is uncontested, it may be approved without a hearing, based on review of the merits of the verified application and supporting exhibits.
