APPLICATION

On April 9, 2015, Anadarko E&P Onshore LLC, Operator No. 2800 ("Anadarko" or "Applicant") filed a verified application pursuant to §34-60-116, C.R.S., for an order to:

- 1) Authorize an additional two horizontal wells, for a total of six horizontal wells, in an approximate 1,302.08-acre drilling and spacing unit for the production of oil, gas, and associated hydrocarbons from the Codell Formation;
- 2) Require the productive interval of any wellbore drilled for the Codell Formation to be located not less than 300 feet from the unit boundaries, unless such boundary abuts or corners lands for which the Commission has not at the time of the drilling permit application granted the right to locate the productive interval of the wellbore no closer than 300 feet from the unit boundary, and not less than 150 feet from the treated interval of any well from the Codell Formation, without exception being granted by the Director.
- 3) Authorize an additional five horizontal wells, for a total of seven horizontal wells, in an approximate 1,302.07-acre drilling and spacing unit for the production oil, gas, and associated hydrocarbons from the Niobrara Formation, and
- 4) Require the productive interval of the wellbore to be located not less than 600 feet from the unit boundaries, and not less than 150 feet from the treated interval of any well from the Niobrara Formation, without exception being granted by the Director.

APPLICABLE RULES AND ORDERS

- Rule 318.a. of the Commission Rules provides a well to be drilled 2,500 feet or greater shall be located not less than 600 feet from any lease line, and shall be located not less than 1,200 feet from any other producible or drilling oil or gas well when drilling to the same common source of supply, unless authorized by the Commission upon hearing.
- On December 15, 2014 (Amended May 19, 2015), Order No. 421-46 established an approximate 1,302.08-acre drilling and spacing unit for the Application Lands, for the production of oil, gas and associated hydrocarbons from the Codell Formation, and approved up to four horizontal wells within the unit.
- On December 15, 2014, Order No. 421-53 established an approximate 1,302.07-acre drilling and spacing units for the Application Lands, for production of oil, gas and associated hydrocarbons from the Niobrara Formation, and approved up to two horizontal wells within the unit
