## APPLICATION

On July 13, 2015, Extraction Oil and Gas, LLC ("Extraction" or "Applicant") filed a verified application pursuant to §34-60-116, C.R.S., for an order to:

- 1) Vacate Commission Order No. 407-1238 only as it applies to the Kodak #5 Well (API No. 05-123-37250).
- 2) Pool all interests in an approximate 280-acre designated wellbore spacing unit for the development and operation of the Niobrara Formation for the drilling of the Kodak #5 Well.
- 3) Subject any nonconsenting interests to the cost recovery provisions of §34-60116(7), C.R.S., effective as of the earlier of the date of this Application, or the date that any of the costs specified in §34-60-116(7)(b), C.R.S. were first incurred for the drilling of the Kodak #5 Well.

- On April 27, 1998, the Commission adopted Rule 318A, the Greater Wattenberg Area Special Well Location, Spacing and Unit Designation Rule.
- On February 19, 1992 (amended August 20, 1993), Order No. 407-87 established 80-acre drilling and spacing units for the production of oil, gas and associated hydrocarbons from the Codell and Niobrara Formations, with the permitted well locations in accordance with the provisions of Order No. 407-1.
- On April 28, 2014, the Commission entered Order No. 407-1025, which pooled all interests in nine approximate 320-acre designated horizontal wellbore spacing units, with each unit covering the same lands consisting of the N½ of Section 28, Township 6 North,

Range 67 West, 6th P.M. for the drilling of the Kodak #4 through #12 Wells, for the development and operation of the Codell and Niobrara Formations.

• On March 16, 2015, the Commission entered Order No. 407-1238, which vacated the pooling provisions of Order No. 407-1025 and pooled all interests in seven approximate 400-acre to 640-acre designated wellbore spacing units established for Sections 20, 21, 22, 27, 28 and 29, Township 6 North, Range 67 West, 6<sup>th</sup> P.M., for the drilling of the Kodak #2 (API No. 05-123-40776); Kodak #3 (API No. 05-123-41120); Kodak #5 (API No.05-123-37250); Kodak #6 (API No. 05-123-37256); Kodak #9 (API No. 05-123-37255) Wells for the development and operation of the Codell and Niobrara Formations.
