To Whom It May Concern:

Petroleum Development Corporation ("PDC") is in possession of a letter from David Neslin, COGCC Director, to Williams Production RMT Company, dated June 19, 2009 (the "Letter"), discussing certain refile circumstances under the new rules. I understand that the COGCC staff is currently working on a guidance document for refileing under various circumstances. However, as there is no guidance document as of yet regarding these particular set of circumstances (i.e. refileing a permit for a location that has already been built), PDC would like to submit under guidance set out in the Letter until such time as a public guidance document is available.

Similar to Williams' stated situation in the Letter, the location for the Chevron 23D-7D was built prior to the effective date of amended rules under a previously approved permit. In order to address the concerns Director Neslin set out in the Letter and to follow the intent of the one year expiration of drilling permits, PDC would like to state the following:

- There is no further surface disturbance planned;
- No variance is created under 306.c.(1)A. or 306.d.(1).;
- The location does not fall within a Restricted Surface Occupancy area.

In order to prevent expiration of the existing permit while waiting for the guidance document, and to minimize gaps in the drill schedule, PDC respectfully requests that the COGCC begin the approval process for this location.
