Dear Mr. Warrens:

I represent Phyllis Hyrup and Hyrup Properties LLC, owners of the surface of the Hyrup Ranch, including the land upon which Hyrup 2-34B is to be drilled. I also represent Hyrup Investments LLC, the owner of all the mineral rights in the Hyrup Ranch.

The Hyrups do not consent to the imposition of conditions on the approval on the 20 well pad or on any other well pad location or well site on the Hyrup Ranch. Careful planning has gone in to locating the drill sites for the development of the gas wells. Locations have been staked out and agreed upon pursuant to the strict provisions of the Lease Agreement which require the approval of the Hyrups.

In addition, Noble is required by the terms of the Agreement reached with the Hyrups, to develop a minimum number of wells during specific time periods. The conditions which DOW has suggested would interfere with carefully negotiated contractual rights and the Hyrups' enjoyment of their private property.

For these reasons, the Hyrups object to the imposition of conditions by DOW upon the development of gas wells on the Hyrup Ranch properties.
