Reason for Report: SPILL **Cause of Condition:** Potential

Receptors:

INITIAL ACTION: During routine tank battery upgrade, leak in dump line from separator was identified, unknown volume of produced water and condensate released to subsurface.

SOURCE REMOVED: Once dump lines were removed, impacted soil was excavated.

HOW REMEDIATE: 540 cu yds impacted soil excavated and disposed offsite at Waste Management landfill in Ault, CO.

MONITORING PLAN: Five monitoring wells were installed on April 3, 2009. Samples were collected and analyzed for BTEX components. Benzene was detected at 20 ug/L in MW-1. A downgradient point of compliance well will be installed prior to next sampling event.

5-RECLAMATION PLAN: The site was restored to pre-release grade. PDC's production facility remains at the site.
