**All representations, stipulations and conditions of approval stated in the Form 2A for this location shall constitute representations, stipulations and conditions of approval for this Form 2 Permit-to-Drill and are enforceable to the same extent as all other representations, stipulations and conditions of approval stated in this Permit-to-Drill.**

Prior to recompleting operator must: 1) Verify existing cement above the Niobrara and across the Fox Hills Aquifer with a cement bond log. 2) If it is not present as follows, provide remedial cement 200' above Niobrara (minimum cement top of 7275'), 200' below Shannon to 200' above Sussex (minimum coverage 5410' to 4390'), and 880' into the surface casing shoe (or 100' plug - if plug from 1000' to 848' is present - it is adequate). Verify remedial cement coverage with cement bond log.
