DeAnne,

I have been reviewing the Nichols 31-11 (PL31SW) **Form 2A** (#400024625). COGCC requests the following clarifications regarding the data EnCana Oil & Gas has submitted on or attached to the Form 2A prior to passing the Oil and Gas Location Assessment (OGLA).

1. **Water Resources (Section 14):** Form 2A indicates the depth to groundwater to be 80 feet bgs for a well located 7182 feet from the well pad. COGCC's review did find one water well (Permit No. 48467-MH-RNI/Dablo, monitoring well) located 7234 feet to the west-northwest, with no available information. There is another water well (Permit No. 216178-Adkins, domestic well) located 12144 feet to the southwest, with a total depth of 480 feet bgs, a depth to groundwater of 334 feet bgs, and a pumping rate of 2 gpm. This well may be more indicative of site groundwater conditions. I can make the change if you send an email with this request. **It is ok to use the domestic water well, Permit No. 216178-Adkins, 12144'.**
2. **Rule 303.d.(3).F.ii.aa and bb:** Please indicate in which cardinal direction the reference area is adjacent to the proposed well pad. I can make the change if you send an email with this request. **The reference area will be located to the South**
