Jessica,

I have been reviewing the Winter Flats 12-33-100 (#400000932) **Form 2A**. COGCC requests the following clarifications regarding the data Black Hills has submitted on or attached to the Form 2A prior to passing the Oil and Gas Location Assessment.

1. **Construction (Section 6):** The dates for construction (10/01/2009) and interim reclamation (03/01/2010) appear to be incorrect since the construction date has already passed. Can you confirm the estimated drilling/completion schedule and these dates. I can make the change if you send an email with this request.
2. **Water Resources (Section 14):** Form 2A indicates the distance to the nearest surface water is 1841 feet. According to the attached hydrology map, the distance to the nearest surface water is 733 feet to the southeast. I can make the change if you send an email with this request.
3. **Rule 303.d.(3).C.:** Neither the scaled Addendum to Legal Plat for Winter Flats 12-33-100 (Sheet 2b of 11) nor the Location Drawing Cut Sheet for Winter Flats 12-33-100 (Sheet 3 of 11), show the location of the proposed gas and water pipelines. One of these drawings should show the anticipated locations of these new and/or existing facilities. Otherwise, a statement indicating that the proposed pipeline locations will follow the access road in the comments section would be sufficient. I can make the change if you send an email with this request. In addition, there needs to be a scaled drawing showing all visible improvements within 400 feet of the proposed disturbance for the pad (there needs to be a line on the drawing at a distance of 400 feet around the edge of the disturbance).
